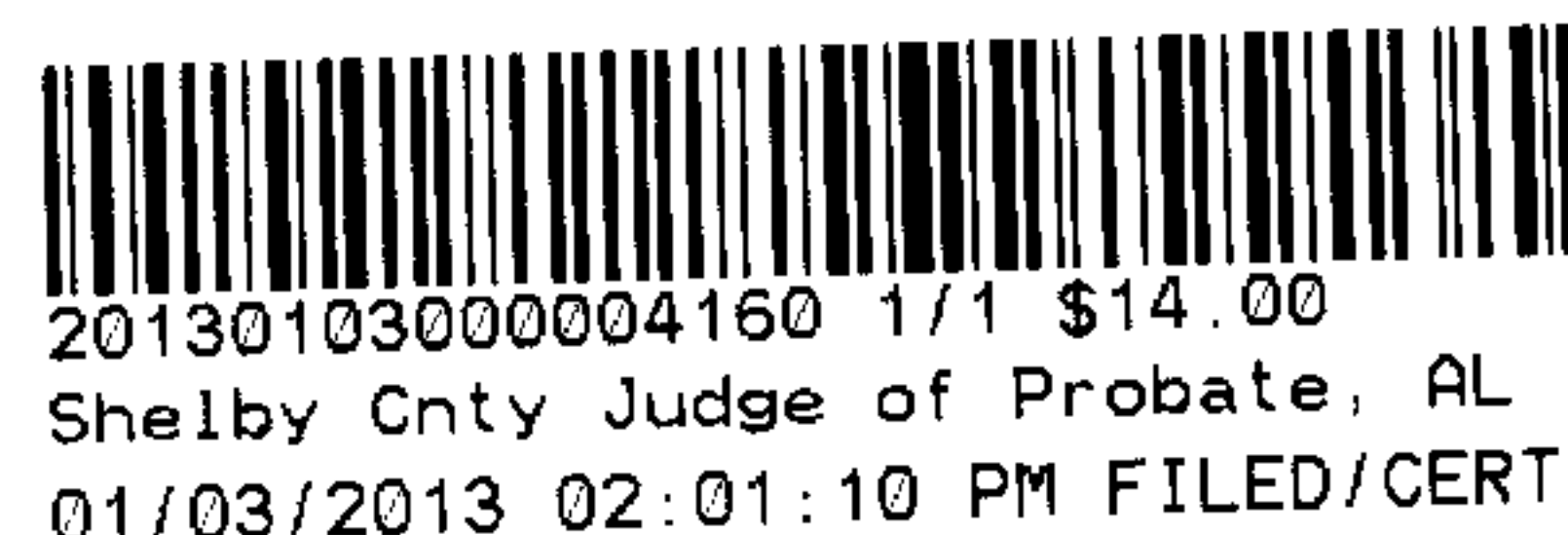


PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE
