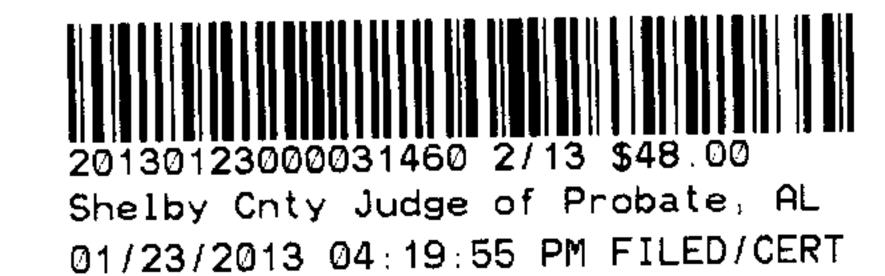

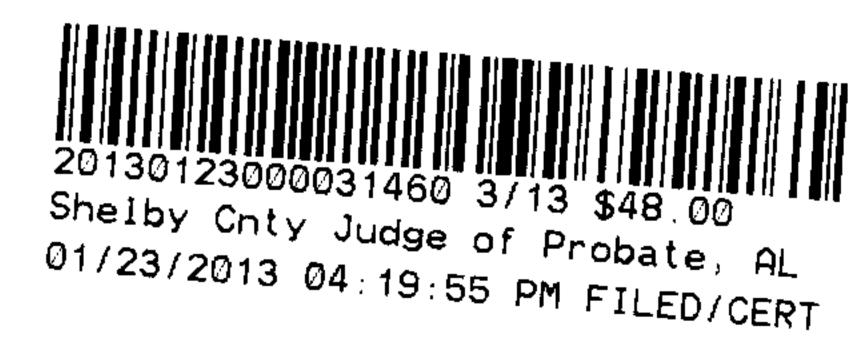

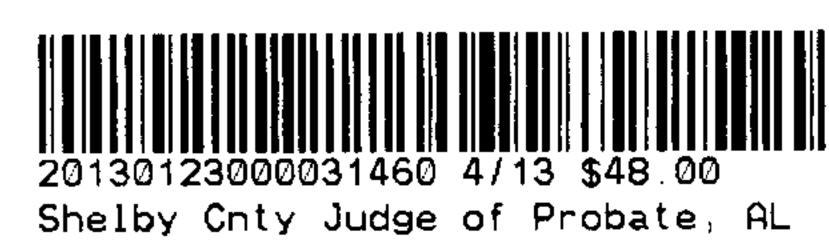

"The landowner owns at least as much of the space above the ground as they can occupy or use in connection with the land."

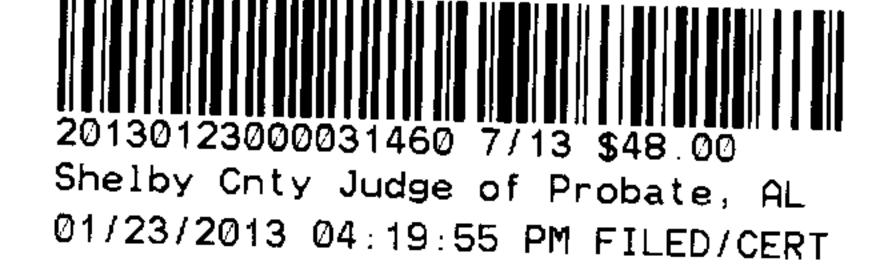
