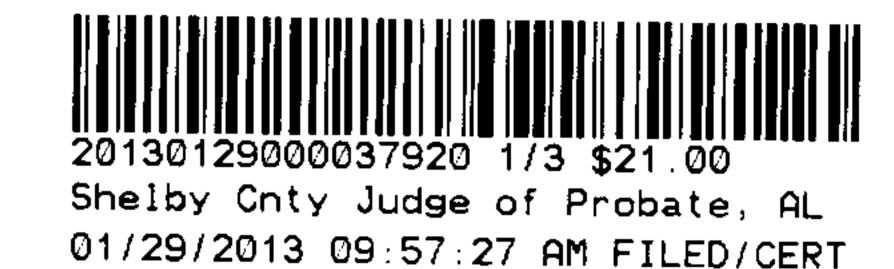

FORECLOSURE DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that, whereas, heretofore on June 16, 2008. to-wit: Rebecca C. Callahan, single woman, executed a mortgage to Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc. solely as nominee for Hamilton Mortgage Corporation, its successors and assigns, herein called the Mortgagee, which said mortgage was recorded on June 27, 2008, in Instrument Number 20080627000263420, Probate Records of Shelby County, Alabama, which conveyed the property hereinafter described to secure the indebtedness evidenced by a note, payable in installments, therein described; which said mortgage was subsequently assigned to JPMorgan Chase Bank, National Association, by assignment recorded October 29, 2012, and recorded in Instrument Number 20121029000414440, Probate Records of Shelby County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, parts of said indebtedness remained unpaid at the respective maturities thereof, and the whole of said indebtedness thereupon became due and payable, and default was made in payment thereof, and thereafter notice was published in The Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation and published in Shelby County, Alabama, on November 28, 2012, December 5, 2012, and December 12, 2012, that the hereinafter described property would be sold at the Shelby County Courthouse at Columbiana, Alabama, at public outcry to the highest bidder for cash, within the legal hours of sale on January 8, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the said sale was held at the time and place stated in said notice, in strict conformity with the powers of sale contained in the said mortgage, at which sale JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., became the purchaser of the hereinafter described property at and for the sum of \$92,650.00, cash, which was the highest, best, and last bid therefore; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, James J. Odom, Jr., conducted said sale and acted as auctioneer thereat, under and pursuant to an appointment as such by JPMorgan Chase Bank, National Association;
