ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GREYSTONE MONTESSORI ACADEMY

TO THE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA:

This is to certify that, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the provisions of Sections 10A-1 et seq., <u>Code of Alabama</u>, <u>1975</u>, as amended (the "Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Act"), the undersigned does hereby make and file the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

<u>Name</u>

The name of the corporation shall be:

GREYSTONE MONTESSORI ACADEMY

ARTICLE II

Duration

The duration and existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

<u>Purpose</u>

- 3.01 The Company (hereafter referred to as the School) is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). The Schools' primary purposes are to build a school that provides education and educational activities that support learning and advancement of all people in our community, incorporating Montessori teaching, principals and guidelines to advance a love of learning, tolerance, understanding, and respect of ones self, others, our state, our country and our world to achieve compassionate citizenship.
- 3.01 (a) School Mission: To foster a learning community of educators, parents, and community members focused on the holistic development of youth, from toddler through high school. Striving to create an environment in which students cultivate a natural passion for learning; respect of themselves, others, and their environment; connect with their community; think internationally, and have the conviction to act on their beliefs to create a more peaceful world.
- 3.01 (b) School Vision: Greystone Montessori Academy is led by its vision to create a safe, top tier institution with a cross-curriculum integrated approach to develop students academically, spiritually, socially, physically, and aesthetically. We envision a school community that is child-centered, community inclusive, and committed to helping students in developing their independence and passions.
- 3.01 (c) School Objectives: The Objectives of Greystone Montessori Academy is to achieve our mission and vision, of building a CIRCLE: Creativity Integrity, Respect, Character, Leadership, and Empathy.
- 3.02 No part of the net earnings of the School shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the School shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No part of the activities of the School shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the School shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or



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distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The School shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.

3.03 Except as hereinbefore limited, the School shall have all the powers by law permitted a corporation organized under the Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV

<u>Operation</u>

- 4.01 The Foundation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.
- 4.02 The Foundation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.
- 4.03 The Foundation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.
- 4.04 The Foundation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.
- 4.05 The Foundation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code, or the corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax law.

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ARTICLE V

Board of Directors

- 5.01 The business and affairs of the Foundation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number of directors, qualifications for directors, and the terms each shall serve shall be provided in the By-Laws of the Foundation. Vacancies in the Board of Directors shall be filled by the remaining directors. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of 1 (one) directors who is the Incorporator.

Members

The Foundation shall have no members, no shareholders or owners of any kind.

ARTICLE VII

By-Laws

The power to adopt, make, alter and repeal the By-Laws of the Foundation shall be vested in the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VIII

Initial Registered Office and Agent

The registered agent of the School shall be Ahrian Tyler Dudley. The registered office of the School shall be 400 Caldwell Trace Birmingham Alabama 35242.


Principal Place of Business

Dissolution
