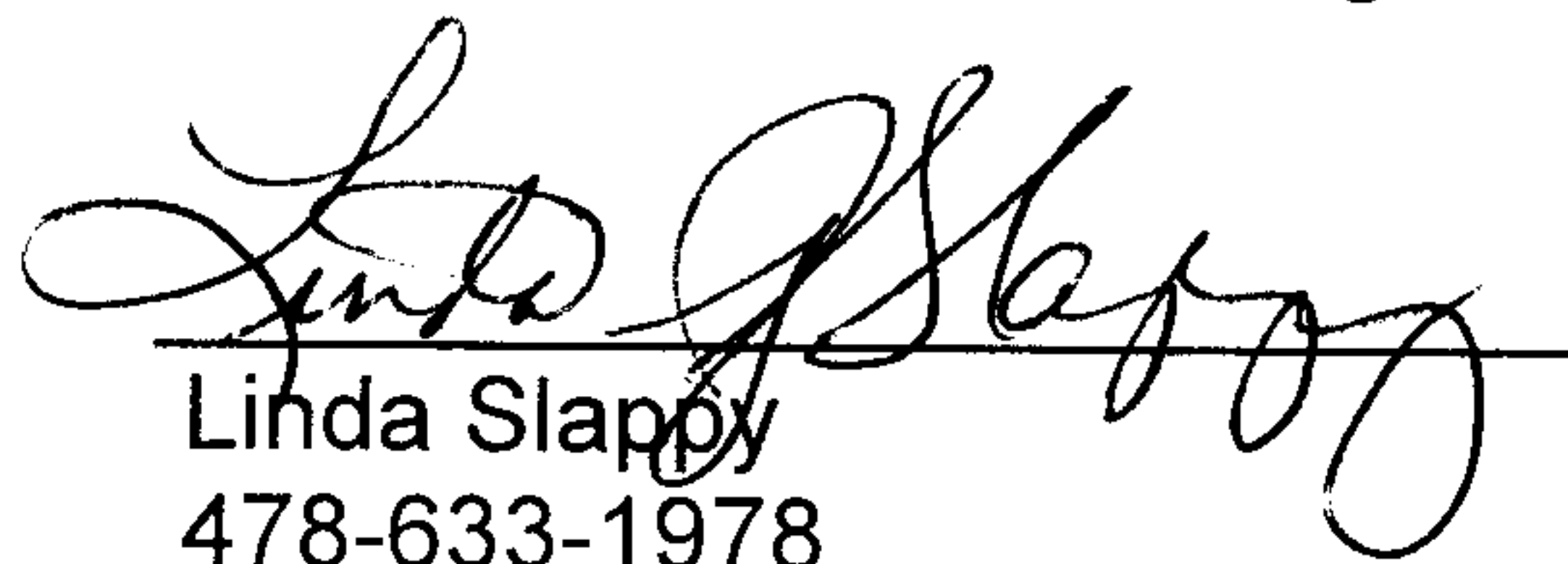
HOSPITAL LIEN AFFIDAVIT

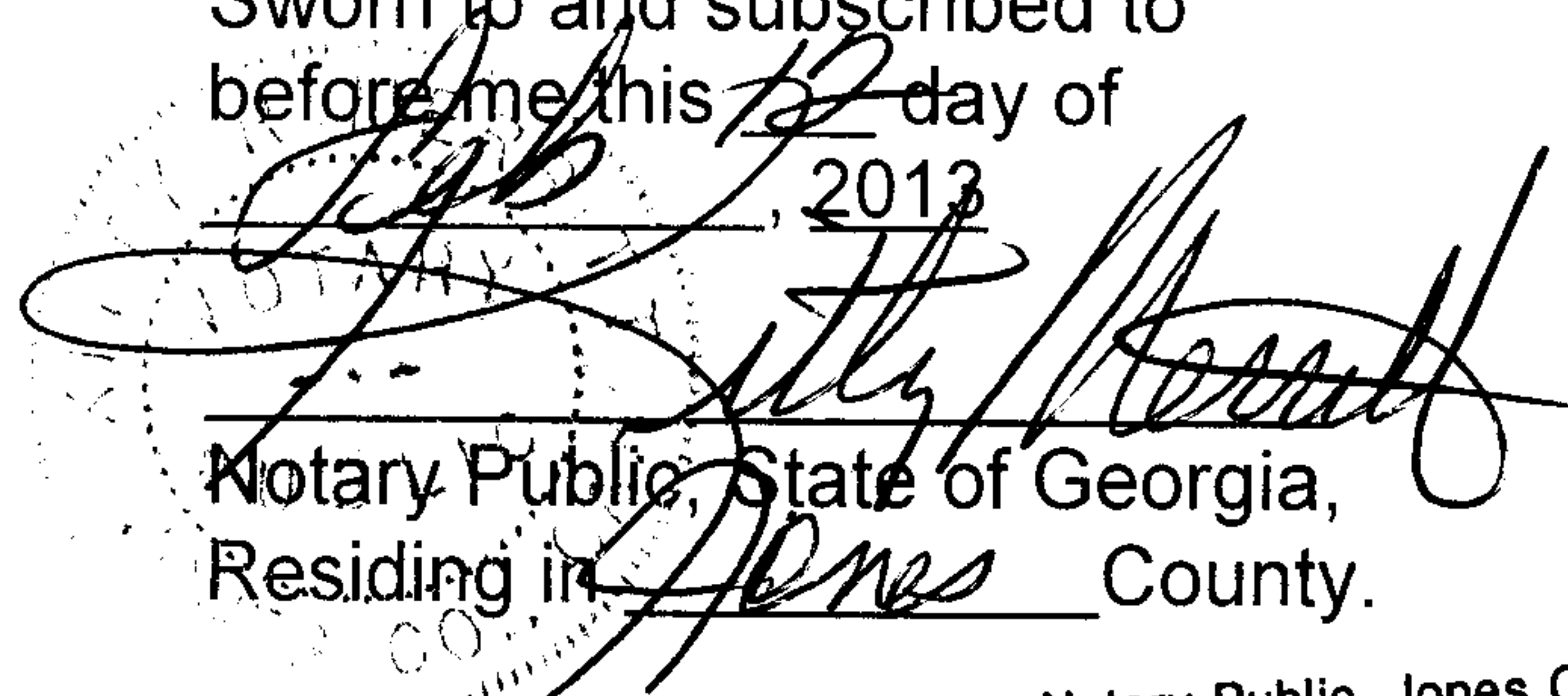
