Gleaves James is the surviving grantee of deed recorded in Instrument No. 20040712000382730. The other grantee, Thomas James, having died on September 11, 2010.

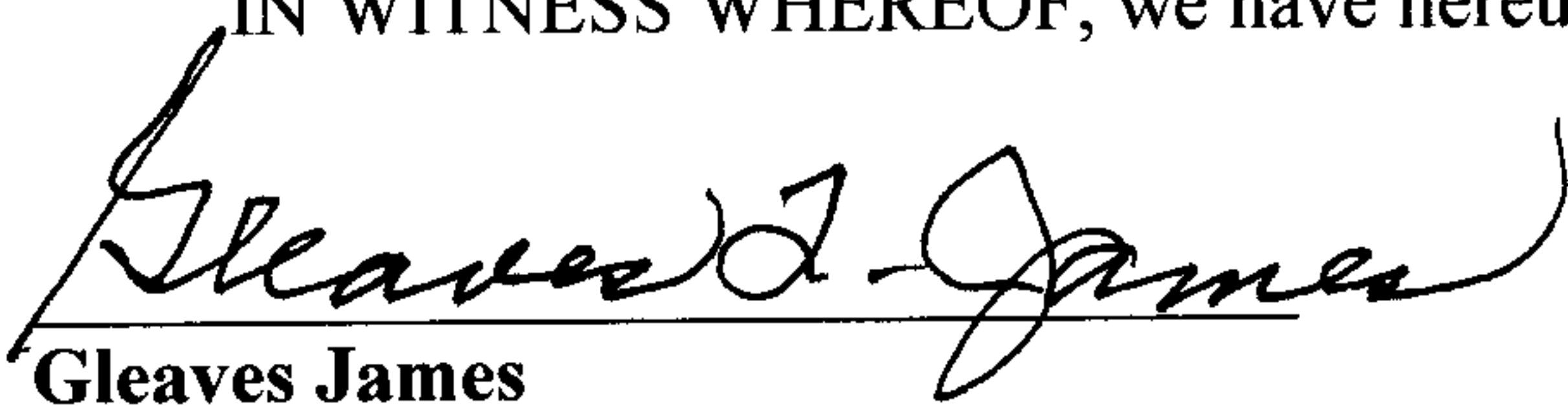
\$190,000.00 of the consideration recited above was paid from a purchase money first mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.

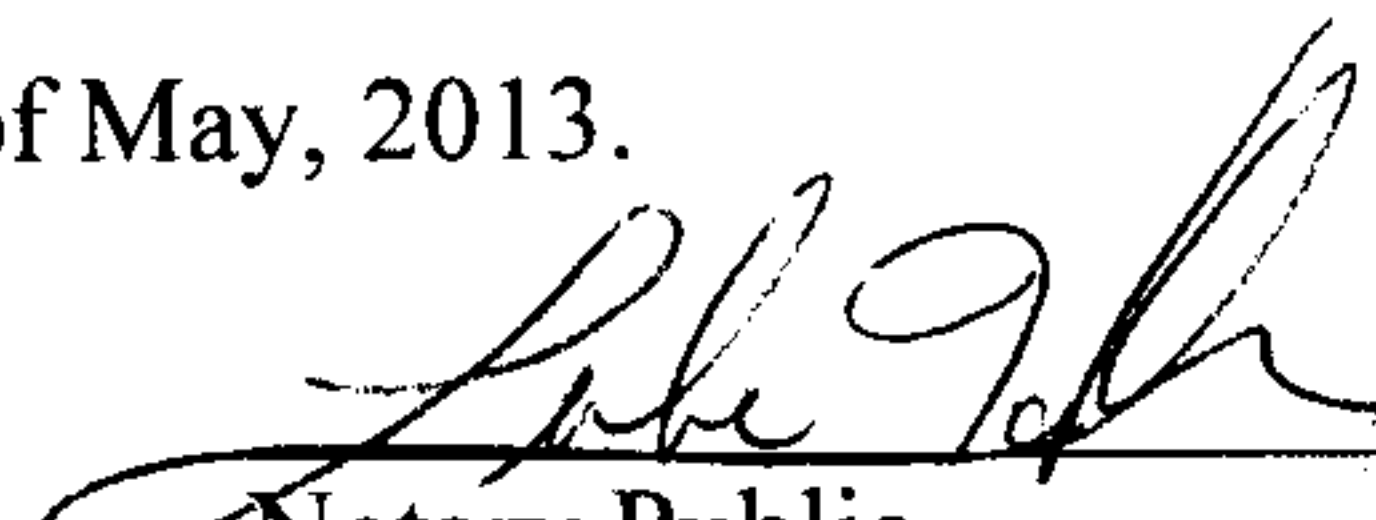

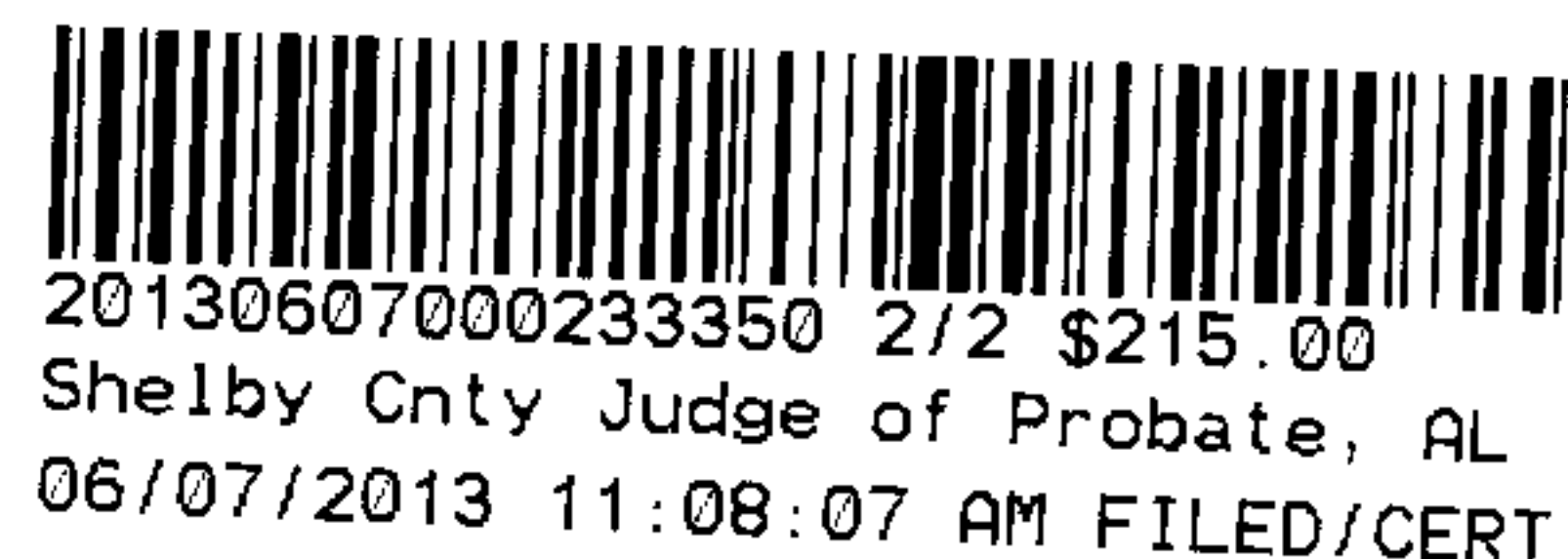
