

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF CHARLES ELLIS SARTORIAL, LLC

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA:

The undersigned, pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law (Chapter 1 and Chapter 5 of the Title 10A of the Code of Alabama (1975)), as amended (the "LLC Law"), hereby delivers these Articles of Organization to the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE I NAME OF ENTITY

The name of the entity being formed is "Charles Ellis Sartorial, LLC" (the "Company").

ARTICLE II TYPE OF ENTITY

The type of entity the Company is being formed as is a limited liability company.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Company is formed are to do and engage in all lawful businesses and activities the Company is not prohibited from engaging in by the LLC Law or by other applicable law.

ARTICLE IV PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of duration of the Company begins on the date of filing these Articles with the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and continues until dissolution of the Company pursuant to the provisions of the LLC Law, these Articles, and the Company's Operating Agreement (if one is in effect), as each may be amended or restated from time to time.

ARTICLE V STREET ADDRESS OF REGISTERED OFFICE; NAME OF REGISTERGED AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Company, and the name of the initial registered agent at that office, are:

ARTICLE VI INITIAL MEMBERS

The Company may have one or more members. The initial number of members of the Company is one, and the name and mailing address of the initial member of the Company are:

Except as otherwise provided herein, the members of the Company have such rights, powers, obligations, and duties as are provided in the LLC Law and the Company's Operating Agreement (if one is in effect).

ARTICLE VII ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

No person may be admitted as an additional member of the Company without the prior written consent of all the then existing members of the Company at the time immediately preceding the person's admission as an additional member.

ARTICLE VIII CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The cessation of membership of one or more members of the Company will not result in the dissolution of the Company except in the following circumstances: (1) upon the occurrence of events specified in the LLC Law as requiring dissolution; and (2) upon the occurrence of events specified in the Company's Operating Agreement (if one is in effect) as requiring dissolution.

ARTICLE IX MANAGEMENT

The Company is managed by its members, subject to the terms of the Company's Operating Agreement (if one is in effect).

ARTICLE X LIABILITIES OF THE MEMBERS

The members of the Company, in such capacities or through such interests, are not liable for any judgment, decree, or order of a court, or in any other manner, for any debt, obligation, or liability of the Company, whether arising in contract, tort, or otherwise, or for the acts or omissions of any other member, agent, or employee of the Company.

ARTICLE XI OPERATING AGREEMENT

Upon the admission of one or more additional members to the Company, the members shall execute an Operating Agreement of the Company that sets forth all provisions relating to the affairs of the Company and the conduct of its business, which provisions must be consistent with the laws of the State of Alabama and these Articles.

ARTICLE XII AMENDMENTS

These Articles may be amended only upon the unanimous written consent of all the then existing members of the Company.

ARTICLE XIII ORGANIZER


