

RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

COUNTY OF ALABAMA § KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, on June 6th, 1980, an Oil, Gas and Mineral Lease (the "Lease") was executed by Linda E. Florey, a widow and Carleen Embry, a widow, as Lessors, and Amoco Production Company, as Lessee, and the Oil, Gas and Mineral Lease being recorded in the Recorder of Deeds for the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, in Book 327, Page 566, and covering and including the following described lands located in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Township 18 South, Range 2 East

Section 25: E¹/₄ of SE¹/₄

Township 19 South, Range 3 East

Section 30: S1/2 of Section 30, lying North and West of Coosa River

Section 31: N1/2 of Section 31 lying North of Locust Creek

Containing 819.05 acres, more or less.

(hereinafter the "Leased Premises"), to which Lease, and the recordation thereof, reference is here made for all purposes; and

WHEREAS, BP America Production Company ("BP"), formerly known as Amoco Production Company ("Amoco") desires to release, relinquish and surrender their right, title, and interest in and to the Leased Premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, BP does hereby release, relinquish and surrender all of their right, title and interest in the Leased Premises.

BP shall retain the right to plug and abandon any and all wells located on the Leased Premises and to remove, for its sole benefit, all surface and subsurface equipment and materials salvaged from such wells; and in connection therewith, BP reserves the right to enter onto the Leased Premises with all equipment and personnel reasonably necessary to plug and abandon any such wells in accordance with the terms of the Lease and applicable governmental regulations.

This release is executed only with respect to any interest of BP America Production Company and is made subject to and without prejudice to the rights of any other parties, including without limitation any rights of assignees or sublessees of BP America Production Company or their predecessors.

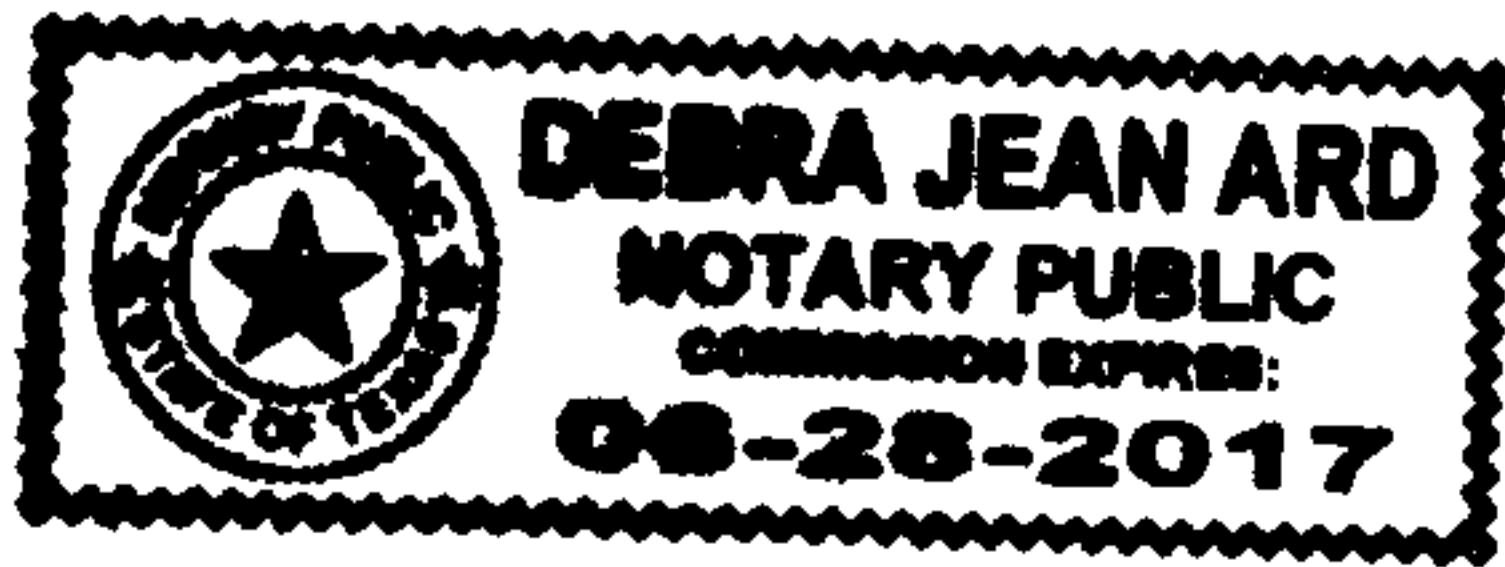
