

- 3. <u>REASON FOR FILING ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION</u>. The Company has disposed of substantially all of its assets, has ceased to carry on its business, and its members have unanimously consented to its dissolution.
- 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. These Articles of Dissolution will be effective on the date on which they are filed with the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.
