Bellamy, an unmarried woman** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTOR does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **Jesse Hicks and Louise Hicks**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of **Shelby**, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 1803, according to the Map of Highland Lakes, 18th Sector, Phase I, an Eddleman Community, as recorded in Map Book 26, Page 130, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

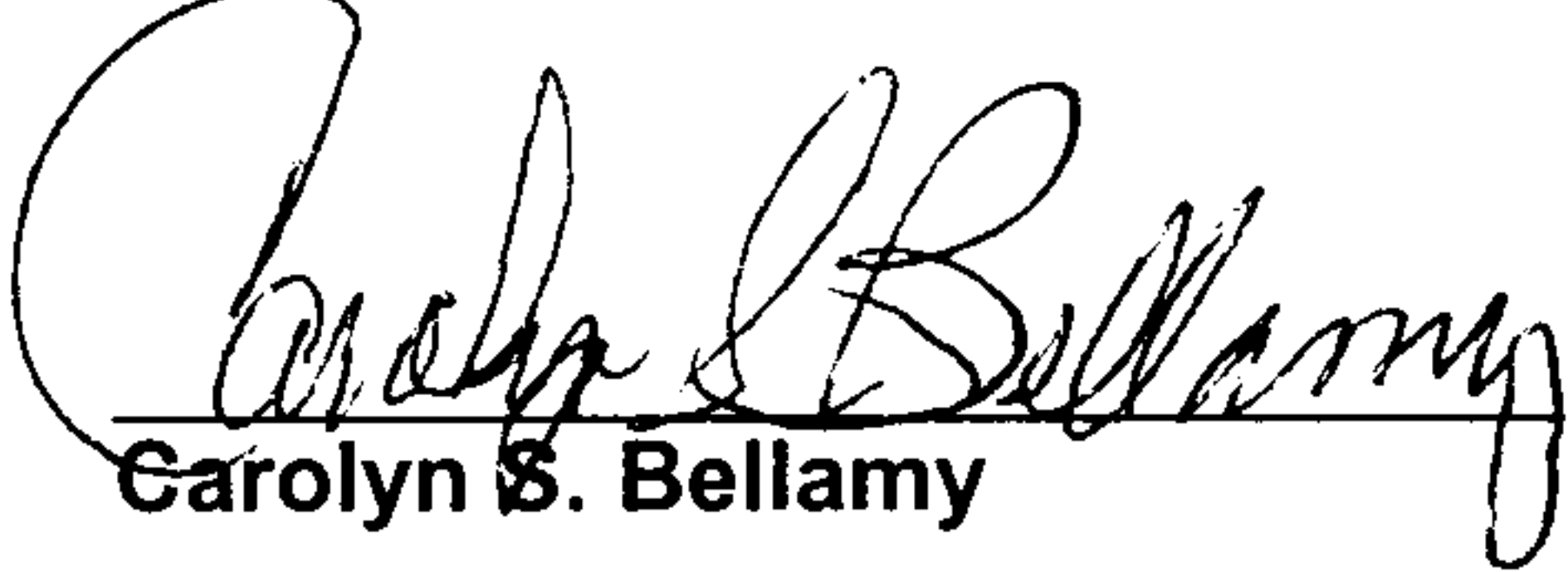

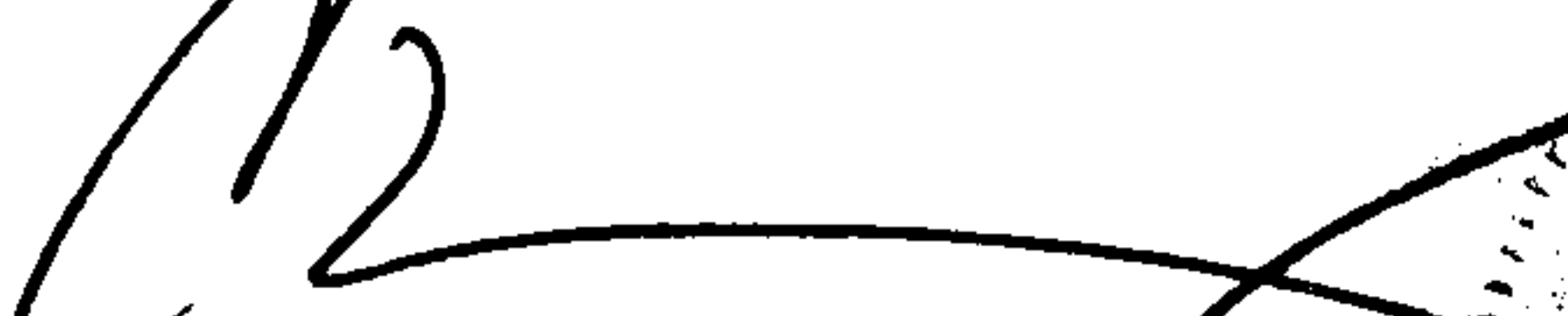
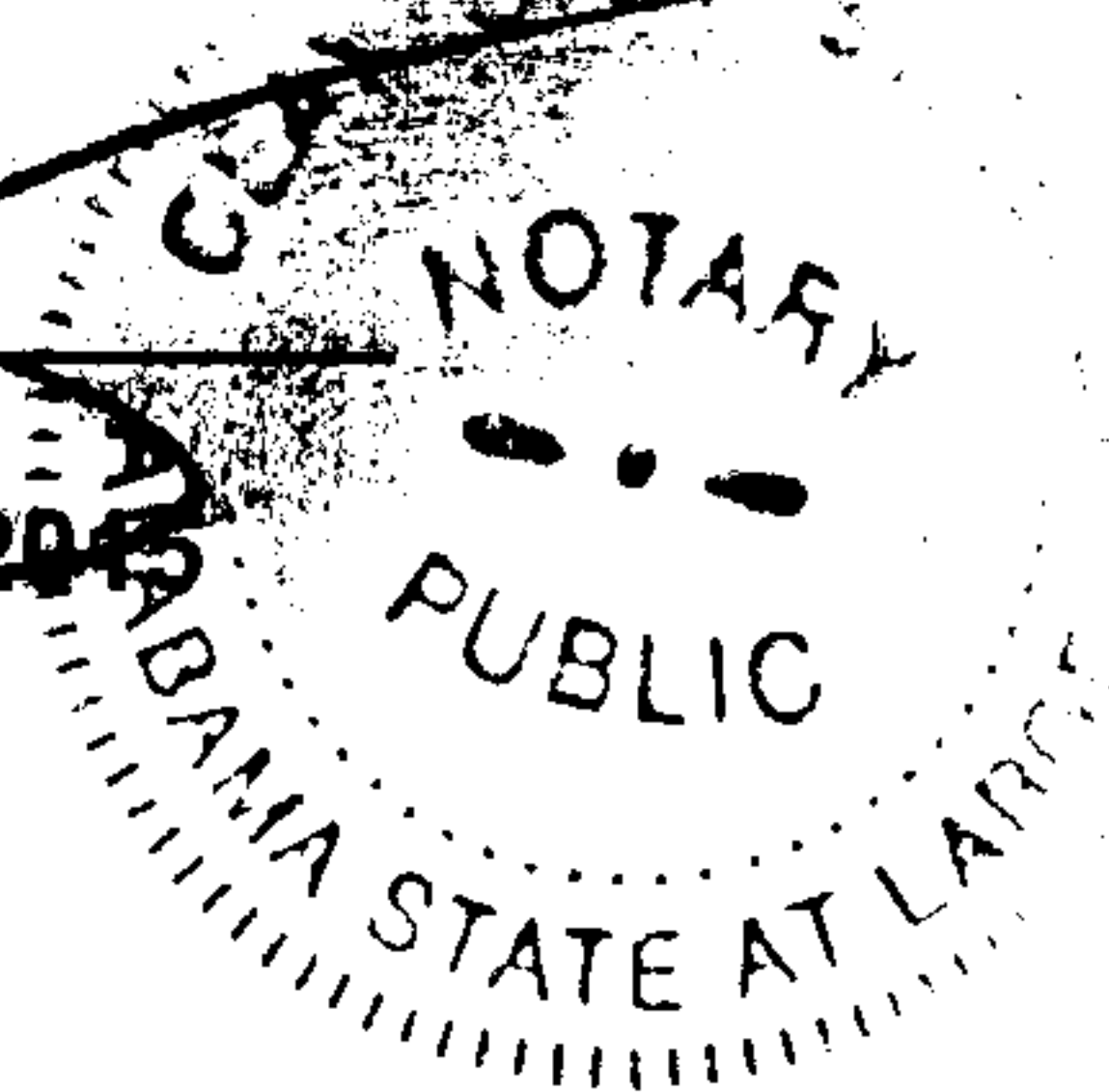
