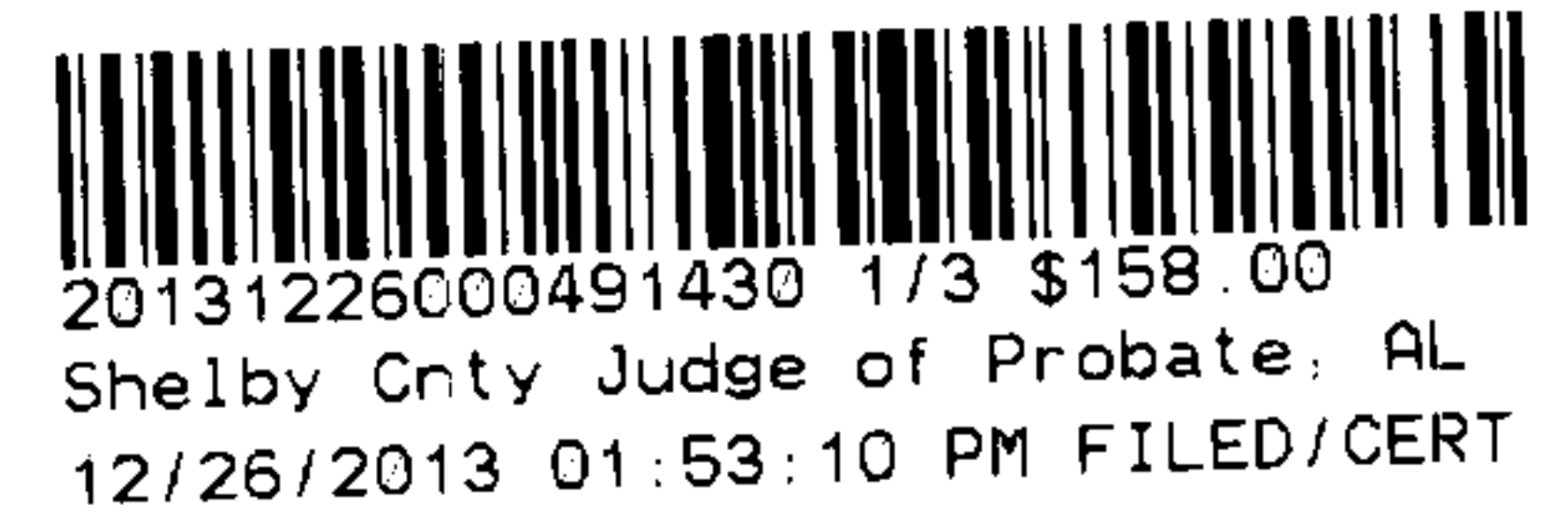


**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF
CAPCON CONTRACTORS,
LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY**



I the undersigned natural person of age, nineteen years or more, acting as organizer of a limited liability company under the Limited Liability Company Act of the State of Alabama, hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for the limited liability company:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the Limited Liability Company is: CAPCON CONTRACTORS, Limited Liability Company.

ARTICLE TWO

ARTICLE THREE

The period of duration of the limited liability company shall be 15 years from its effective date.
