WARRANTY DEED WITH JOINT RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP

**STATE OF ALABAMA

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

On this December 30, 2013, That for and in consideration of **ONE HUNDRED SIXTY TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$162,000.00) DOLLARS**, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned **ROBERT M. NEEL and BARBARA MCNORTON NEEL**, husband and wife, (herein referred to as "Grantors"), in hand paid by the Grantees herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Grantors do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Grantees, **PATRICK DEAVOURS and DANIELLE DEAVOURS**, (herein referred to as "Grantees"), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, all of the Grantors' interest in the following-described Real Estate situated in, **SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA**, to wit:

Lot 13, according to the Survey of Aaron Parc, as recorded in Map Book 22, Page 40, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to:

1. General and special taxes or assessments for the year 2014 and subsequent years not yet due and payable.
2. Municipal improvements, taxes, assessments, and fire district dues against subject property, if any.
3. Mineral and mining rights not owned by Grantors.
4. Any applicable zoning ordinances.
5. Easements, encroachments, building set back lines, rights-of-ways as shown of record by recorded plat or other recorded instrument, including any amendments thereto.
6. All matters, facts, easements, restrictions, assessments, covenants, agreements and all other terms and provisions in Map Book , Page .
7. Such state of facts as shown on the plat of Aaron Parc, as recorded in Map Book 22, Page 40, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
8. Subject to Covenants, conditions, and restrictions as set forth in the Document recorded in Instrument No. 1997-6311 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
9. Right of Way to Alabama Power Company, recorded in Deed Book 244, Page 672; Deed Book 244, Page 674; Deed Book 101, Page 551 and Deed Book 112, Page 49, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

10. Right of way to the City of Pelham, recorded in Deed Book 143, Page 349 and Deed Book 143, Page 351, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

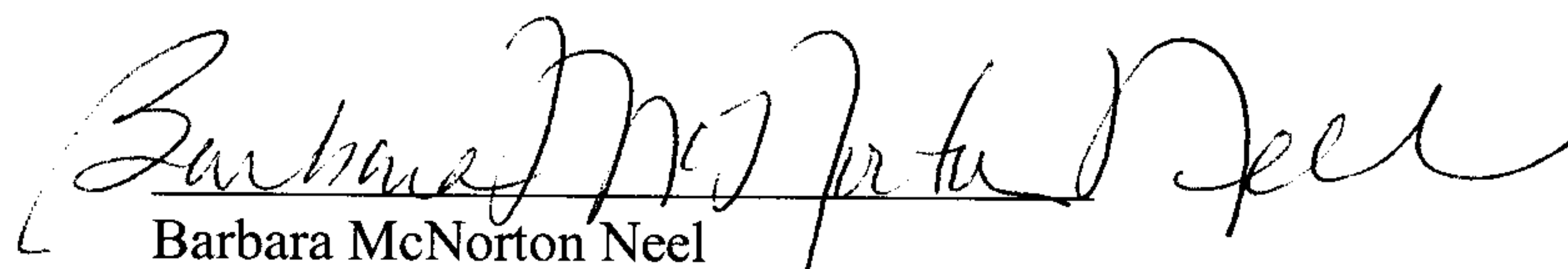

AND SAID GRANTORS, for said GRANTORS', GRANTORS' heirs, successors, executors and administrators, covenants with GRANTEES, and with GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, that GRANTORS are lawfully seized in fee simple of the said Real Estate; that said Real Estate is free and clear from all liens and encumbrances, except as hereinabove set forth, and except for taxes due for the current and subsequent years, and except for any restrictions pertaining to the Real Estate of record in the Probate Office of **SHELBY COUNTY**; and that GRANTORS will, and GRANTORS' heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to said GRANTEES, and GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all persons.

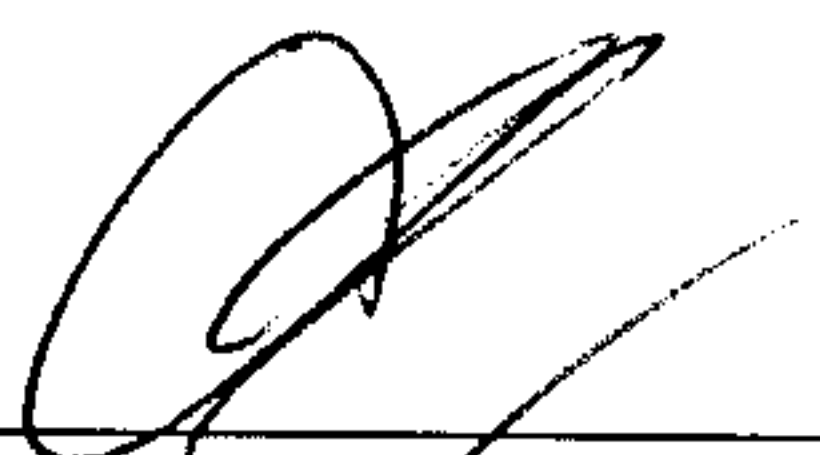

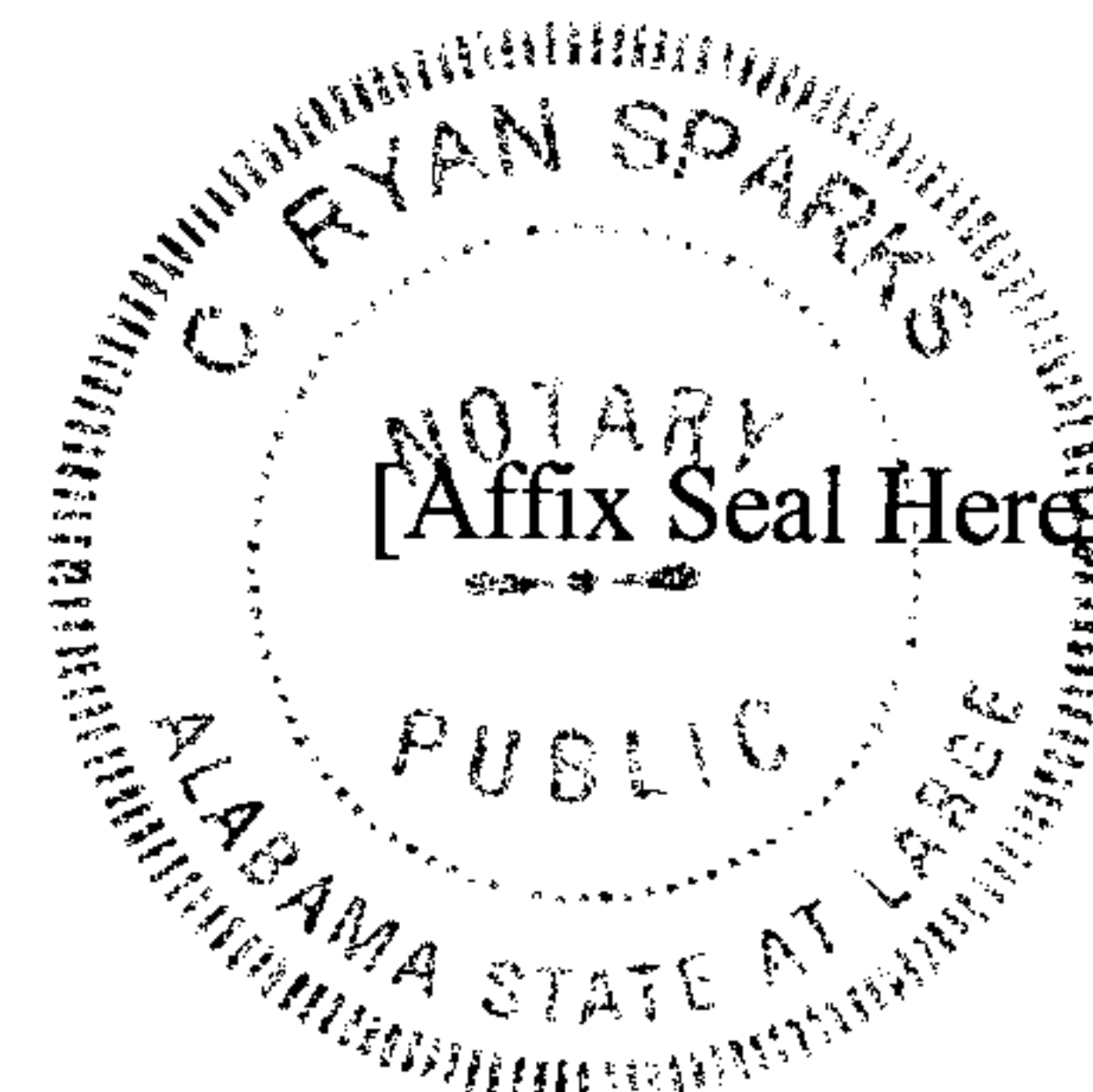
