Amendment 1 DISSOLUTION

1.1 Dissolution

CF Riders is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of CF Riders shall benefit or be distributed to its members, officers, or directors, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions to further the purposes set forth in the purposes clause herein.

Upon termination or dissolution of CF Riders, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed for one (1) or more of exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principle office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
