

## ACTION BY WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE SOLE SHAREHOLDER AND DIRECTOR OF ADVANCED RESULTS, INC. AS OF APRIL 15, 2014

The undersigned, being the sole shareholder and director of Advanced Results, Inc., an Alabama corporation (the "Corporation"), hereby consents to the adoption of the following resolutions without a special meeting and agrees that such actions are taken with like effect and validity as though taken by the unanimous affirmative vote of all the shareholders and directors at a special meeting duly called and legally held as of the date of this written consent, and directs that this written consent be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Corporation.

**RESOLVED**, that the Corporation be voluntarily dissolved in accordance with the provisions of Section 10A-2-14.02(f) of the Code of Alabama (1975), as amended;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the officers of the Corporation be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, in the name, and on behalf of, the Corporation, to execute, deliver and file with the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, Articles of Dissolution prepared in accordance with Section 10A-2-14.03 of the Code of Alabama (1975), as amended;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that after filing the Articles of Dissolution, the Corporation shall proceed to collect its assets, convey and dispose of such of its properties as are not to be distributed in kind to its sole shareholder, pay, satisfy, discharge or make provision for the discharge of its liabilities and obligations and do all other acts required to wind up and liquidate its business and affairs, and after paying or adequately providing for the payment of all its obligations, the Corporation shall distribute the remainder of its assets, either in cash or in kind, to its sole shareholder; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the proper officers of the Corporation be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, in the name, and on behalf of, the Corporation, to execute and deliver such certificates and documents and do all other such acts as may be appropriate or as may be required by law in connection with the said voluntary dissolution.
