ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

Pursuant to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, the undersigned Hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be Compass Home Builders LLC

ARTICLE TWO DURATION

The period of duration of the limited liability company shall be perpetual, except as otherwise provided herein.

ARTICLE THREE PURPOSES

The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the purpose of engaging in a business to own, operate, construct, modify and manage real property and for the further purpose of transacting any or all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be formed under the Alabama Limited Liabilities Act, as from time to time amended.

ARTICLE FOUR Registered Office & Agent

ARTICLE FIVE

Membership

B. <u>Additional Members</u>: Additional members may be admitted upon approval by members holding at least eighty-five percent (85%) of the membership interests in accordance with such other terms, conditions and procedures as may be imposes from time to time in the Operating Agreement of the Limited Liability Company.

ARTICLE SIX

Continuation of Business

Upon the occurrence of an event of dissociation, which results in one or more members being terminated from membership, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business of the limited liability company upon the affirmative vote by the members holdingat least eighty-five percent (85%) of the membership interests: provided, however, that there shall at all times be not less than two members of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE SEVEN MANAGEMENT

The management of the limited liability company shall be vested in a manager. The name and address of the person(s) who shall serve as manager until the first annual meeting of the members or until his successor is elected and qualified is:

ARTICLE EIGHT POWERS

The limited liability company shall have all powers given to limited liability companies by the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act and such other acts or laws as may be applicable to limited liability companies in the State of Alabama and such other jurisdictions in which this limited liability company may be doing business.

ARTICLE NINE POWER OF ATTORNEY

Each member, including new members who may be admitted from time to time hereafter, by the execution of these Articles of Organization, or an amendment hereto, irrevocably constitutes and appoints the manager of this limited liability company as his true and lawful attorney-in-fact with full power and authority in his name, place and stead to execute, acknowledge, deliver, swear to, file and record at the appropriate public offices, such documents as may be necessary or appropriate to carry out the provisions of these Articles of Organization and the Operating Agreement of this limited liability company, including but not limited to:

- (a) All certificates and other instruments (including counterparts to this Agreement), and any amendment thereof that the manager deems appropriate to form, quality or continue the company as a limited liability company in the jurisdictions in which the company may conduct business or in which such formation, qualification, or continuation is, in the opinion of the manager, necessary to protect the limited liability of the members.
- (b) All amendments of the Articles of Organization adopted in accordance with the terms hereof (but not by a vote using the power of attorney) and all instruments that the manager deems appropriate to reflect a change or modification in accordance with the terms of these Articles of Organization or the Operating Agreement, including documents concerning the admission of additional members pursuant to Article Five hereof.
- (c) All conveyances and other instruments that the manager deems appropriate to reflect the dissolution and termination of the company.

This power of attorney may be exercised by any manager, acting alone, for each member, or by listing all of the members and executing any instrument with a single signature of any manager as attorney-in-fact for all of them.

This appointment by all members of the manager as attorney-in-fact shall be deemed to be a power coupled with an interest, in recognition of the fact that each member under these Articles of Organization shall be relying upon the power of the manager to act as contemplated by these Articles of Organization and the Operating Agreement and any filing in any other action on behalf of the company, and shall survive the incapacity of any person hereby giving the power and the transfer or assihnment of this interest. The foregoing power of attorney of a member shallsurvive each transfer only until such time as the transferee shall have been admitted to the company as a new member and all documents and instruments shall have been executed, filed, and recorded to effect a substitution of membership.
