This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, **Motion for Default Judgment and Default Judgment taken against Defendant**

and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill. The Court being satisfied from all the testimony that there exists such a complete incompatibility of temperament that the parties can no longer live together.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Plaintiff and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said _____

ALBERT PURNELL JONES is forever divorced from the said

SHARON SWAIN JONES

for and on account of incompatibility of temperament between the parties.

Be it further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Plaintiff, Albert Purnell Jones, be awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the minor children born of this marriage; being Albert Purnell Jones, Jr. and Eric Demon Jones. Be it further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the real property as described in the attached Exhibit A be awarded to the Plaintiff subject to encumbrances of record.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party shall marry again except to each other until 60 days after the date of this divorce decree and if an appeal is taken (which must be instituted within 42 days from this decree or from the date that a post trial motion is denied), then neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of the appeal.

It is further ordered that Albert Purnell Jones and Sharon Swain Jones be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that _____ the plaintiff pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.
