

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

LIQUID LIGHTNING, LLC

**To the Honorable Judge of Probate in and for Shelby County,
Alabama:**

The undersigned, acting as Organizers of a limited liability company under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for Liquid Lightning, LLC:

FIRST: The name of the Company is Liquid Lightning, LLC.

SECOND: The Company shall continue in existence until it is dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the operating agreement, or, if there is no operating agreement or no provision in the operating agreement governing the duration of the Company, then in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, or other applicable laws.

THIRD: The Company is organized for the purpose of engaging in the business of purchasing, sales and investment in real estate and related properties. To that end the Company shall possess all the powers necessary to conduct a business and to carry out the objects expressed herein, together with all of those powers expressly conferred upon Limited Liability Companies or enumerated in Title 10 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, as last amended. The Company shall also have all powers bestowed upon Limited Liability Companies under any of the laws of the State of Alabama, as well as those necessarily implied.

FOURTH: The mailing address of the initial registered office of the Company is 199 Weatherly Way, Pelham, AL 35124 and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is Terry L. Van Doren.

FIFTH: The names and addresses of the initial Members of the Company are:

SIXTH: The initial Members of the Company may admit

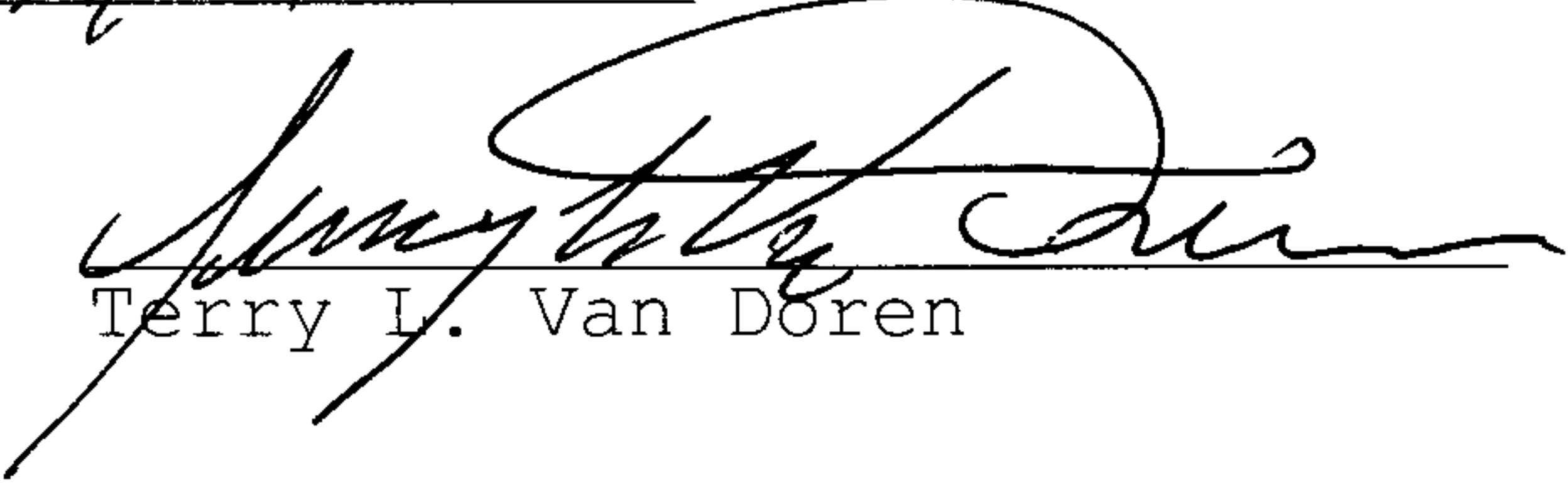
additional Members at such times and upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed by the Company and the additional Members.

SEVENTH: The Company shall be managed by its Members.

EIGHTH: Each member shall be entitled to one vote on any matter requiring a vote.

NINTH: The Articles of Organization may be amended by a unanimous vote of the Members, except that in the event the Company has more than three Members, the Articles may be amended by a vote of a majority of the Members.

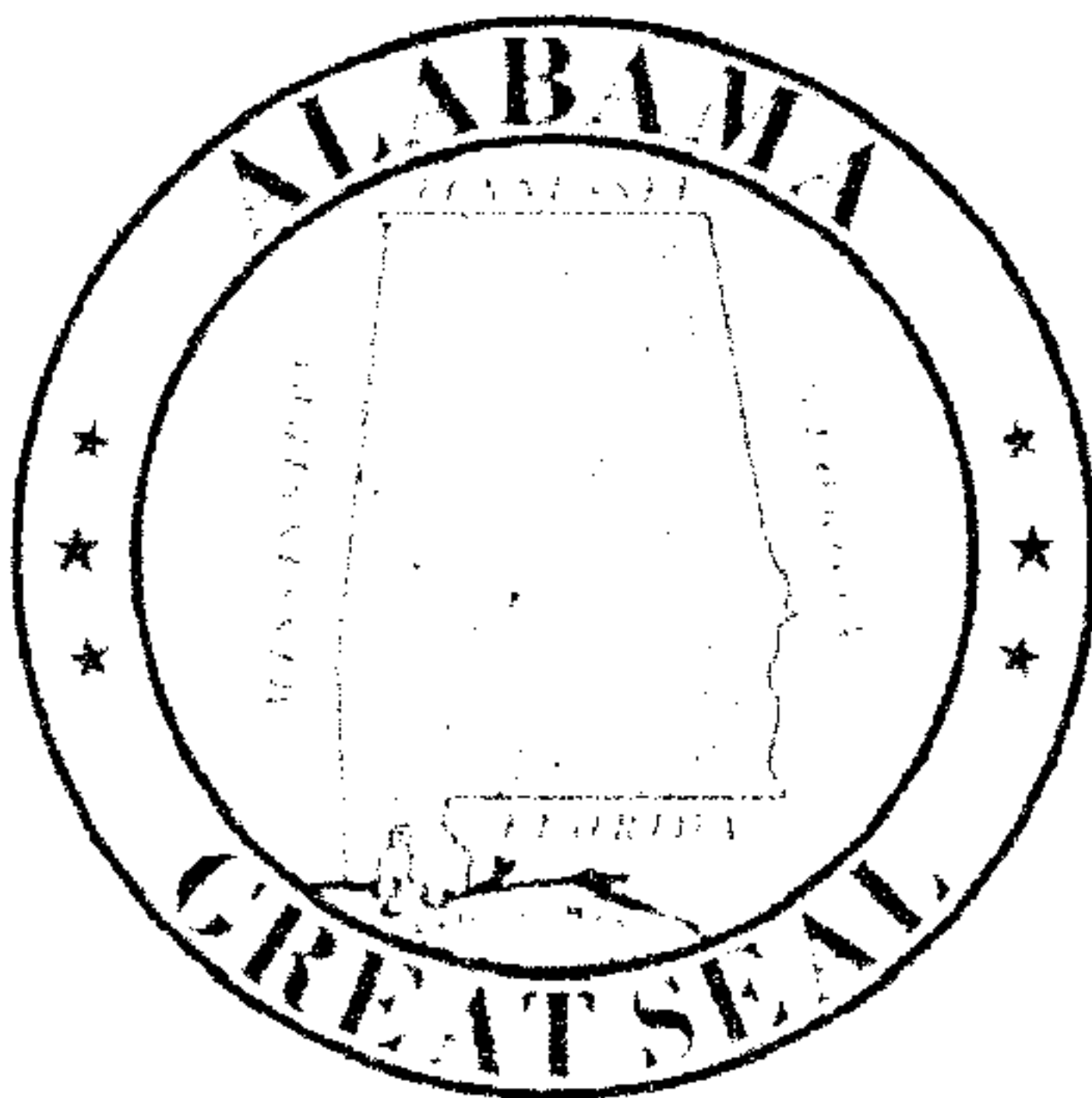
