I, J. J. Nolen, of Shelby County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this as my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills or codicils, if any, heretofore made by me:

ITEM ONE: It is my desire and I hereby direct that all of my just and legal debts, including my funeral expenses and the expenses of my last illness, be paid out of my estate as soon after my death as may be practicable and convenient.

ITEM TWO: I hereby give, devise, and bequeath to my wife, Ruby Lee Nolen, all property which I may own at the time of my death, or in which I may have an interest, real, personal or mixed, and wherever situated, to be hers absolutely.

ITEM THREE: In the event my wife, Ruby Lee Nolen, should predecease me or we should die at the same or approximately the same time as the result of a common disaster, then the debt secured by the mortgage recorded as Instrument No. 1997-10561 is forgiven in full and the mortgage is to be released, and I give, devise, and bequeath all of my property to my following named children in the proportions designated:

If either of them should predecease me, then the share to which such child would have been entitled shall go to the survivor. If both of them should predecease me, then my property shall go to James

ITEM FOUR: I hereby nominate and appoint my wife, Ruby Lee Nolen, as executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, but if she is unable or unwilling to serve, I then appoint my children, Linda Sue Walker and Donna Lynn Cooper as co-executrices. If either of them should be unable or unwilling to serve, then the other shall serve as sole executrix. I hereby relieve and exempt them from making bond and also from the filing of any accounts, appraisals, inventories, or settlements in any court pertaining to the administration of my estate. I hereby give them the power and authority to sell, if necessary to the administration of my estate, any real, personal, or mixed property of my estate at public or private sale at their discretion, and to execute all deeds, mortgages, powers of attorney, assignments, releases, and any other documents in connection with the administration of my estate without having to obtain the approval of any court. If a public sale, either may be the purchaser if the highest bidder therefor.

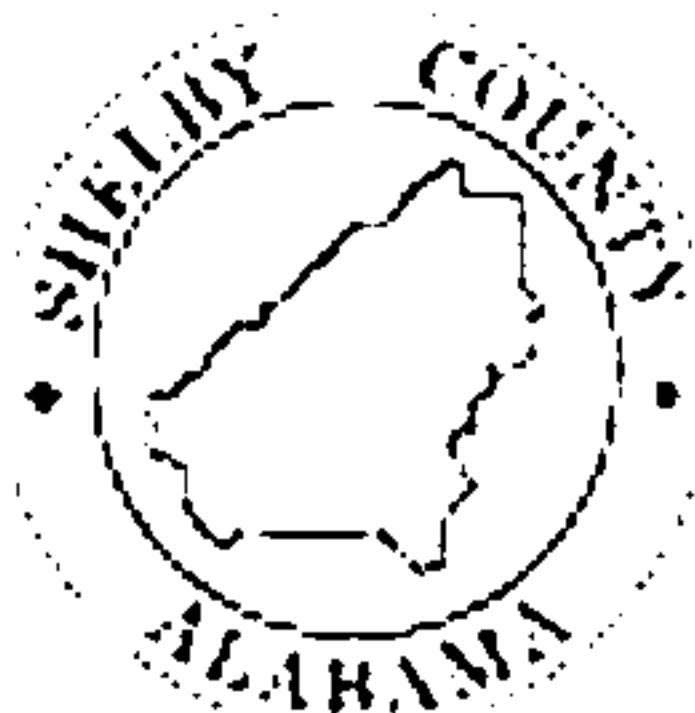
