To the best of my knowledge there has been no administration on the estate of decedent. To my knowledge there are no debts of any kind against the estate of decedent except as follows:

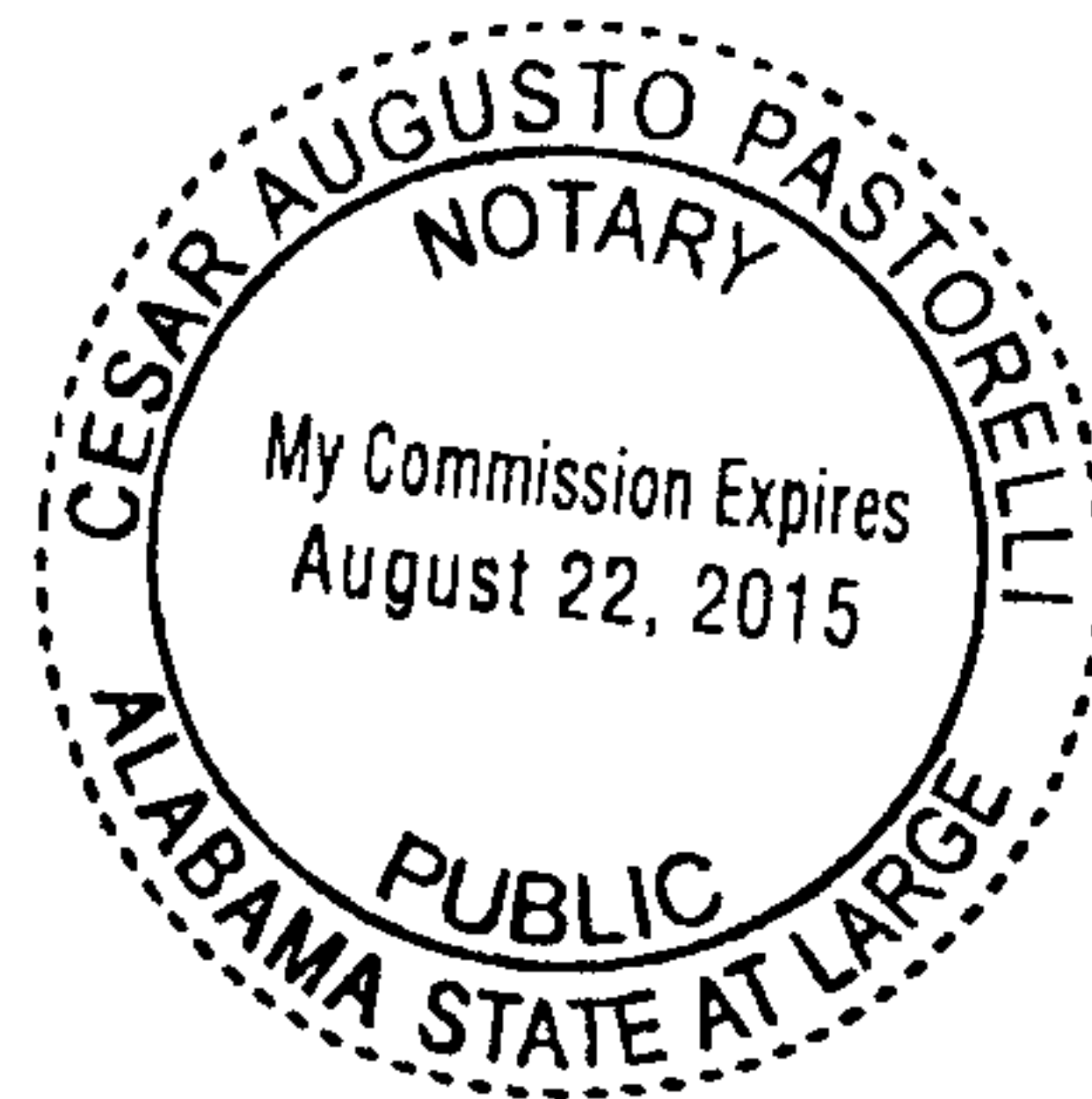
