GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 (\$14,400.00) Dollars, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned GRANTOR, **Estate of Ray H. Moore**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTOR does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **Jeanne Kathryn Roberson and husband, Anthony Keith Roberson**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of revision, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 3, according to the Survey of Deer Meadow Farms, as recorded in Map Book 44 page 56 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

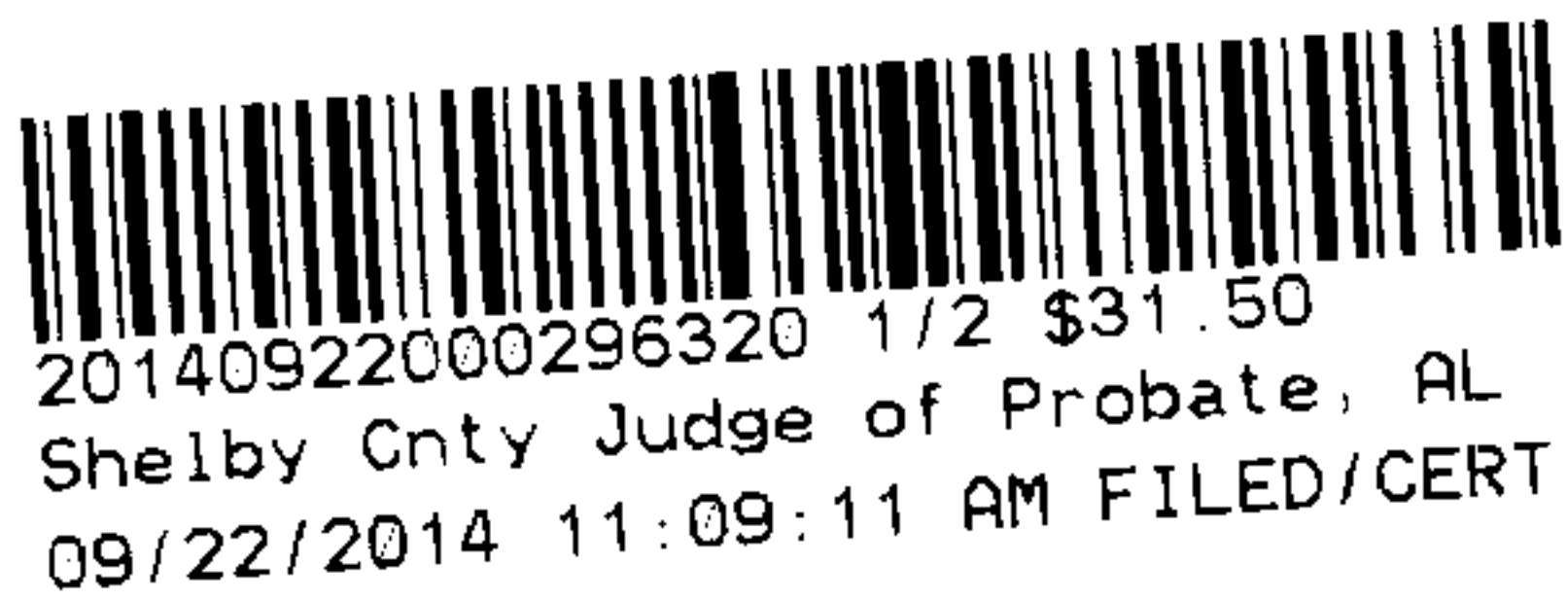
Subject to existing easements, current taxes, restrictions, set-back lines and rights of way, if any, of record. Subject to any accrued taxes or assessments not yet due and payable.
