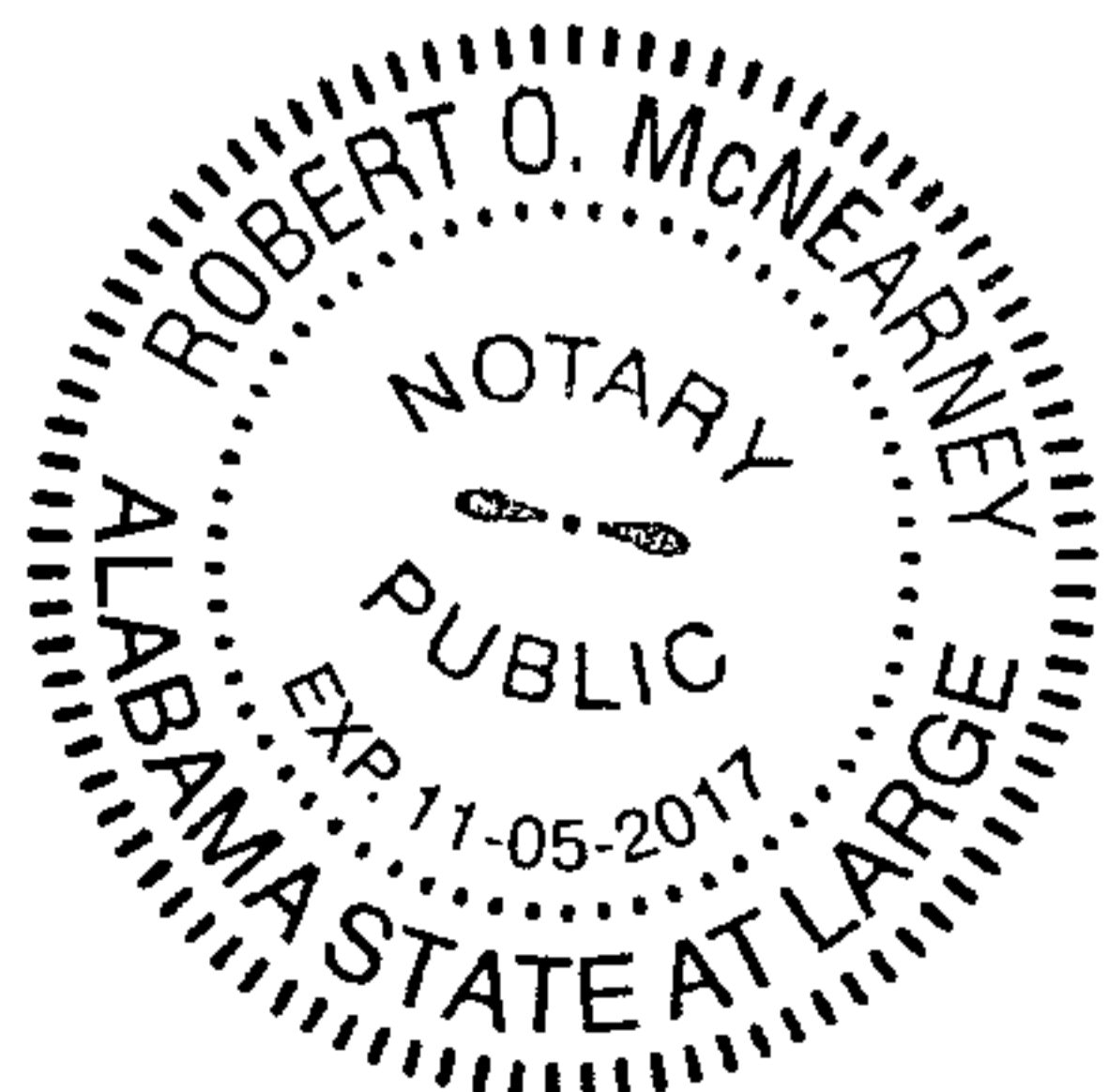


Comes now **JOSEPH W. STRICKLAND**, Attorney at Law and Notary Public (hereinafter "Affiant"), and states the following:
