
## ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

## ABELL LAW, LLC



## A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF ALABAMA

Pursuant to the *Code of Alabama Title 10-12-1*, the undersigned, acting as the organizer of a limited liability company under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (hereinafter called the "Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization for <u>Abell Law, LLC</u> (hereinafter called the "Company").

Drafter's Note: All bolding, italicization, underlining, or other formatting of the text contained in these Articles is solely for stylistic purposes, and does not reflect the legal or general intent of the drafter.

- 1) Name: The name of the Company shall be Abell Law, LLC.
- 2) <u>Period of Duration</u>: The Company shall exist in perpetuity, until it is dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the operating agreement, or, if there is no operating agreement or no provision in the operating agreement governing the duration of the Company, then in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, or other applicable laws in the State of Alabama.
- 3) <u>Company Purpose</u>: The Company is primarily organized for the purpose of engaging in the business of practicing law. In addition, the Company is organized for the purpose of conducting any other lawful business.
- 4) <u>Initial Registered Office</u>: The mailing address of the initial registered office is: <u>2363 Lakeside Drive</u>, <u>Suite 103</u>, <u>Birmingham</u>, <u>AL 35244</u>.
- 5) Initial Registered Agent: The name of the initial registered agent of the Company is Nathaniel Callistus Abell.
- 6) <u>Initial Member/Organizer</u>: The name and address of the initial member and organizer of the Company is: <u>Nathaniel Callistus Abell; 2363 Lakeside Drive, Suite 103, Birmingham, AL 35244</u>.
- 7) Membership and Rights to Expand: The initial organizing member of the Company may admit additional members to the L.L.C. upon full payment by the new member of their equity share, as agreed to by the L.L.C. organizing member and the new member. At any time during which there exists more than one member of the Company, the Company may admit additional members to the L.L.C., subject to the unanimous vote of current members, and upon full payment by the new member of their equity share as agreed upon by the new member and existing members.

- Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation: Contingent on the assent of the majority of Company members, these Articles may be modified. All members shall receive actual notice of the proposed amendment before filing with the probate court, unless such would bring the Company into noncompliance with applicable law. If actual notice is not possible within the timespan required by §10-12-11(b), notice shall be given by the managing member at the earliest possible time. Modification procedures shall be in accordance with Alabama Code §10-12-11, in addition to any other requirements provided by law.
- **Dissolution**: Where the legal existence and business of the Company is discontinued and/or dissolved by one member and that member decides for any reason that cessation is in the best interest of the L.L.C., said act shall constitute sufficient reason for the dissolution of the Limited Liability Company or by unanimous agreement of all members of the L.L.C.
- Manager Name and Address: The Company shall be initially managed by Nathaniel C. Abell, who shall serve as such until his successor is duly elected. The manager's address is: Post Office Box 1381, Tuscaloosa, Alabama 35403.
- Powers: In compliance with §10-12-10 (b) of the Code of Alabama, these Articles will not include the enumerated powers of the L.L.C. which can be found, for reference, in the L.L.C.'s Bylaws.


