Parcel I:

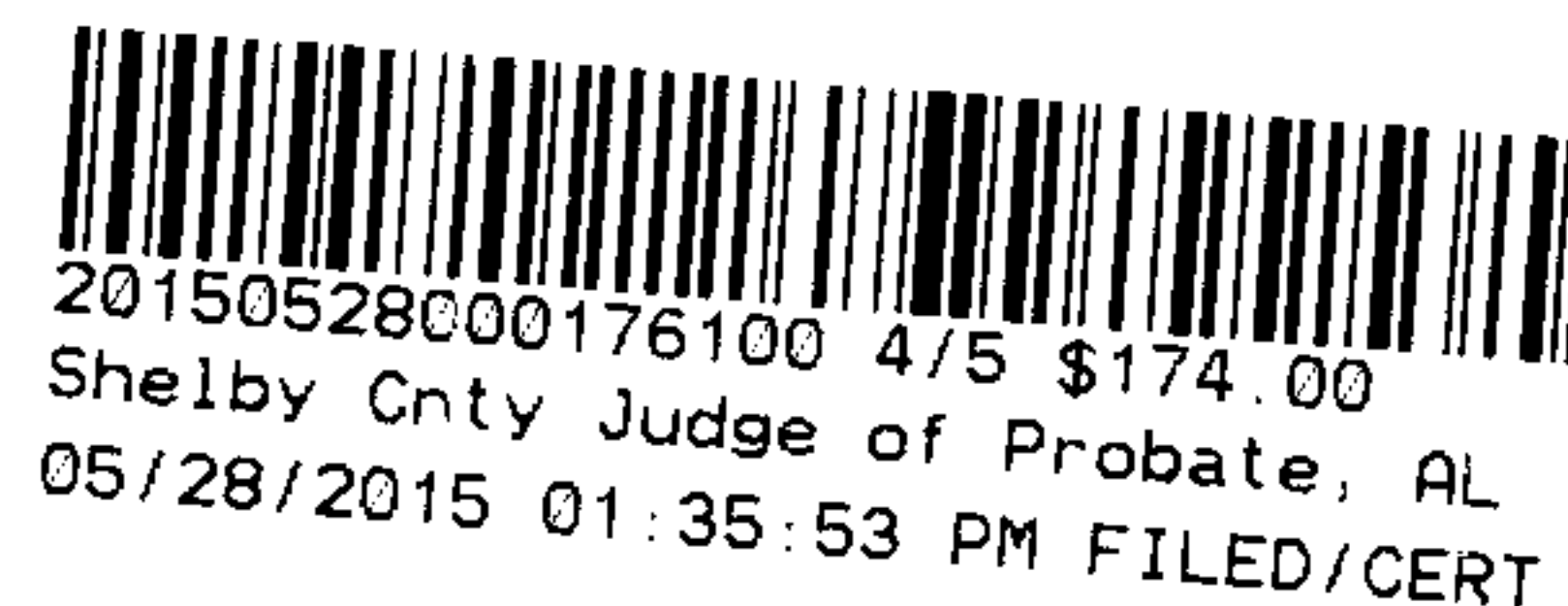
