Affiant further states that the said decedent departed this life on February 8, 1991, in El Paso County, State of Texas, being 73 years old at the date of death.

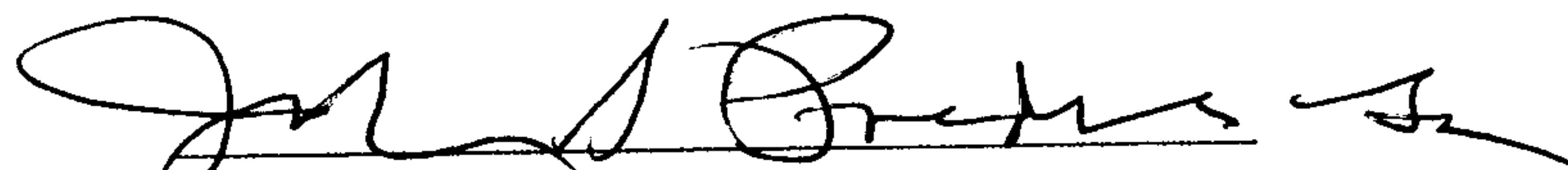

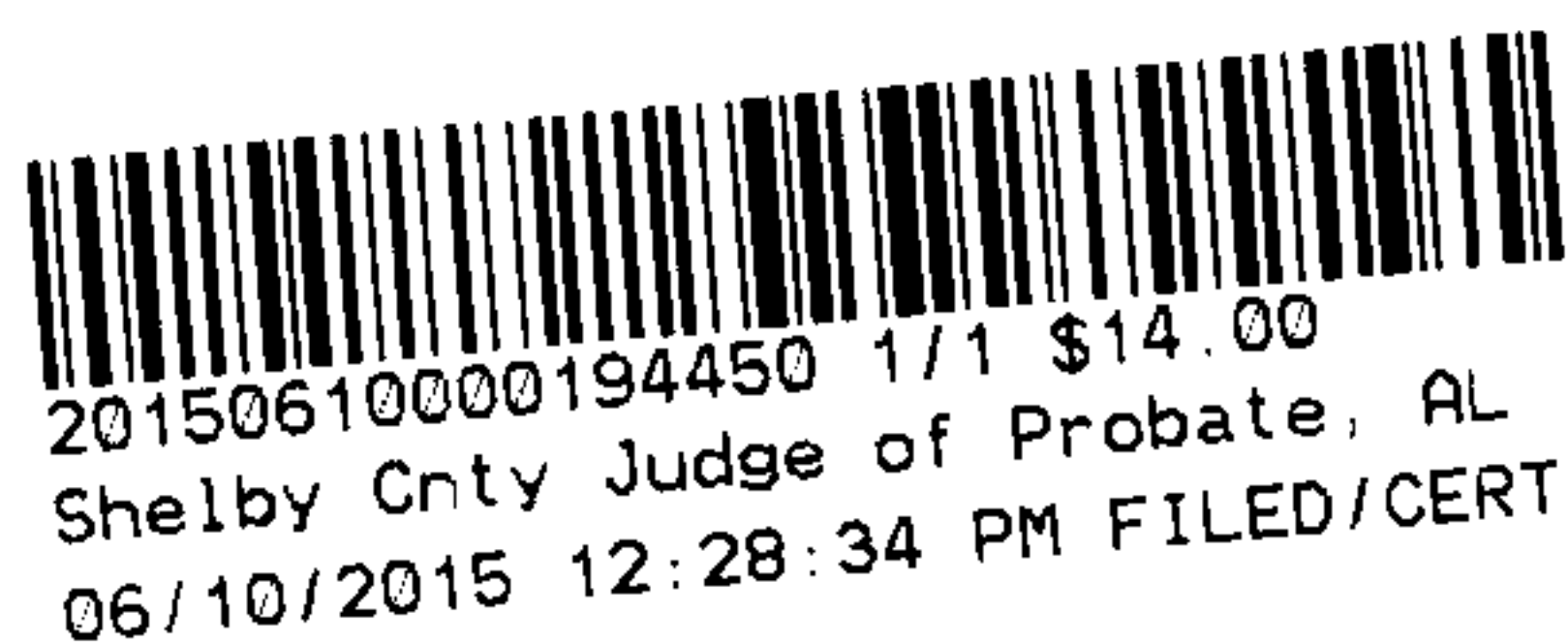
Date of Death: December 30, 1983
