LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, JACK HOLMES NAISH, of said State and County, being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make and publish this my Last Will and Testament, expressly revoking any and all others heretofore made by me.

ITEM I

I direct that all of my just debts, including expenses of last illness and cremation, shall be paid from my estate as soon as practicable. Cremation expenses shall include any reasonable or necessary costs and expenses, as conclusively determined by Executor, for cremation, memorial services, for travel of my next of kin to attend, and for transport and disposition of remains, including expenses of cremation.

ITEM II

In the event my wife, JANE EVELYN DECKER NAISH, survives me, by a period of thirty (30) days, I give, bequeath and devise all of my property, both real and personal and wherever located, including any lapsed or void legacy to be hers in fee simple.

ITEM III

In the event my wife, JANE EVELYN DECKER NAISH, predeceases me or in the event that we shall die as a result of a common disaster wherein it is difficult to determine which of us survived the other or she shall fail to survive me by a period of thirty (30) days, then in any of the above events, I give, bequeath and devise my estate as follows:

(a) I give the books constituting my personal library to those children surviving me, the same to be divided among them as they may agree. I suggest that they give such of the books for which any one of them does not have a need, use, or sentimental regard to Wieuca Road Baptist Church or to NFBE of SBC Brotherhood Commission presently in Memphis, TN, to be dispensed by my children.

(b) I give any jewelry, clothing; pictures; silver; silverware; china; objects of art; household appliances,



furniture, and furnishings; or other personal effects except books constituting my personal library; as well as any motor vehicles, boats, trailers, domestic animals, or other tangible personal property of which I die possessed and any items of my personal property having little but sentimental value, as conclusively determined by Executor, to my children, substantially share and share alike, per stirpes, and in consideration of any expressions from time to time made by me during my lifetime and of the respective needs, uses, or sentimental regards any may have for any particular item.

(c) If the gross value of my estate exceeds \$300,000.00 then in that instance I bequeath the sum of \$10,000.00 to Richmond Baptist Theological Seminary in Richmond, Virginia for the establishment of a trust fund for scholarships to aid women in the ministry.

(d) I give and bequeath a sum equal to Three (3%) per centum of my gross estate, but not in excess of Ten Thousand and no/100 (\$10,000.00) Dollars, to Belmont University in Nashville, Tennessee, to invest the principal and use the income earned therefrom to provide scholarship aid for meritorious students of music as shall be determined by the dean or other controlling faculty member of the music department of the College.

ITEM IV

Each eleemosynary body herein named as a legatee shall include such other entity into which such a body may be merged or consolidated or by which such a body may be succeeded or, if any such a body shall for any other reason not be in existence at my death, then the Executor shall determine in his or her sole discretion of such Executor what other existing entity most closely then serves the same purposes as such named body as existing on the date of execution hereof and substitute such other then existing entity for such then non-existing body.

ITEM V

All of the rest, residue and remainder of my property I give and bequeath in equal shares to my three children,

namely; ALEESA JANE NAISH, PHILIP LYNN NAISH AND TIMOTHY LEE NAISH. If any of my children should predecease me leaving lineal descendants, then the share that would have gone to said child shall be divided per stirpes among his/her lineal descendants, if any, or if none then to his/her surviving brothers or sister in equal shares.

ITEM VI.

I hereby name and appoint my wife, JANE EVELYN DECKER NAISH, to serve as Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. In the event she should predecease me, decline to serve, or for any reason cannot serve, or after having qualified, dies, resigns, or becomes incapacitated, then I name and appoint JAMES ODELL MEADOWS, to serve as Executor of my Estate. In the event he should predecease me, decline to serve, or for any reason cannot serve, or after having qualified, dies, resigns, or becomes incapacitated, then I name and appoint my son, PHILIP LYNN NAISH to serve as Executor of my Estate. The Executor of my Estate shall have the authority to exercise any and all of the fiduciary powers which are enumerated in O.C.G.A. 53-12-232 and made a part hereof by reference thereto.
