

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF JAMES A. DAWSON, LLC**

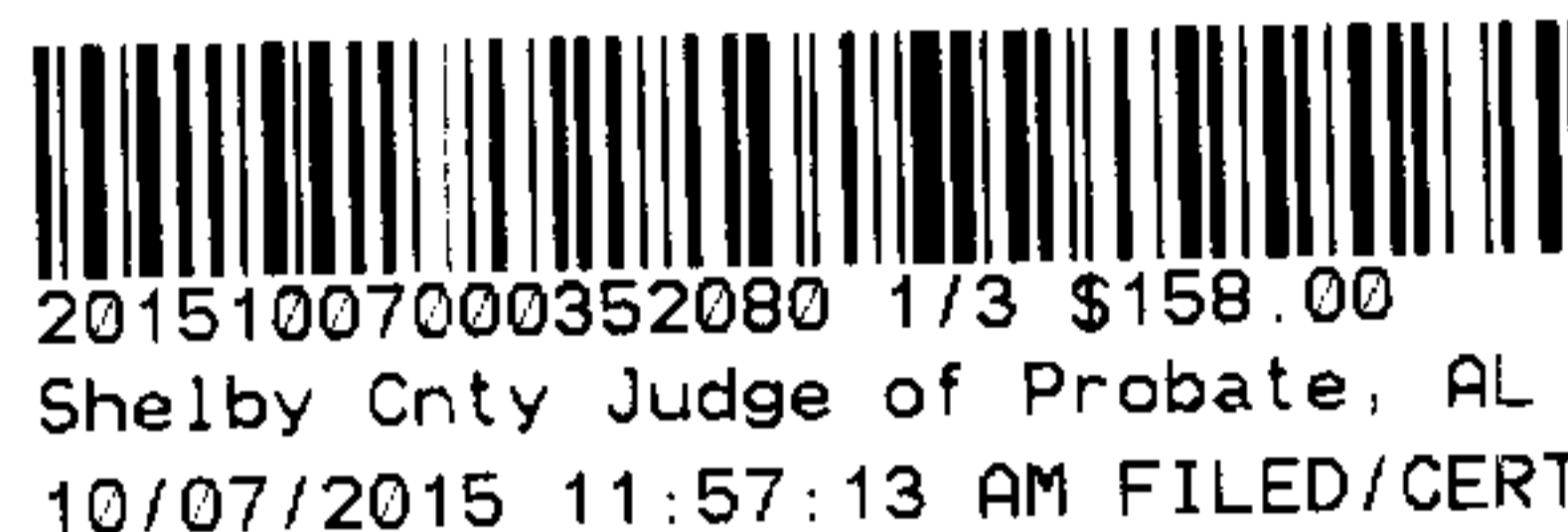
Pursuant to the Provisions of Act No. 93-274 of the 1993 Alabama Legislature, the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

THE NAME OF THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IS:

**ARTICLE II
DURATION**



The period of the duration is perpetual.

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSES**

The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purposes:
For the purpose of doing business in residential and commercial real estate, which may involve sales, development, purchasing and leasing, and investments of residential and commercial property, including but not limited to renovations, pre-sales, speculative investments with residential, agricultural and commercial property. To engage in the transactions of any and all other lawful business for which a L.L.C. may be allowed under the Laws of the State of Alabama. The foregoing purposes and activities will be interpreted as examples only and not as limitations and nothing herein shall be deemed as prohibiting the L.L.C. from extending its activities to any related or otherwise permissible lawful business purpose which may become necessary, profitable or desirable for the furtherance of the objectives expressed. This LLC shall not be limited to this sole purpose.

**ARTICLE IV
REGISTERED AGENT/OFFICE**

Shall be granted upon the majority election of the present members.

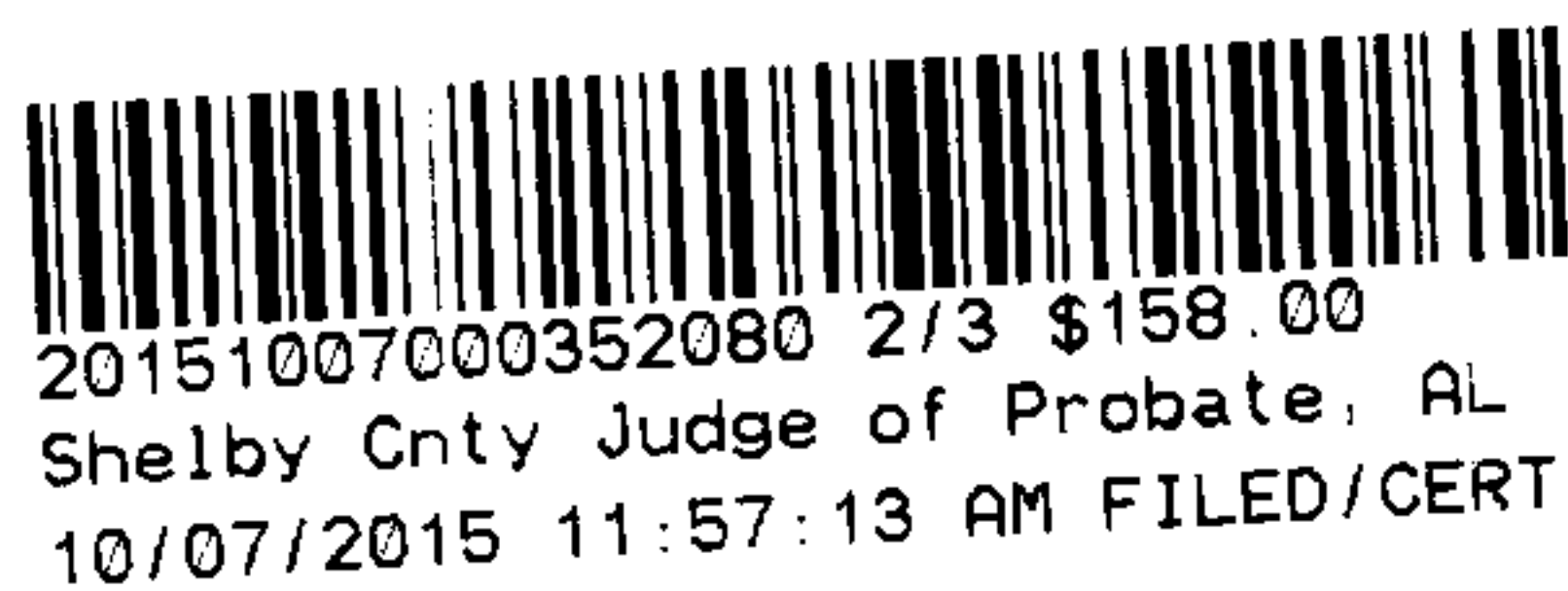
ARTICLE VIII
CONTINUANCE OF THE LLC AFTER DISSOCIATION

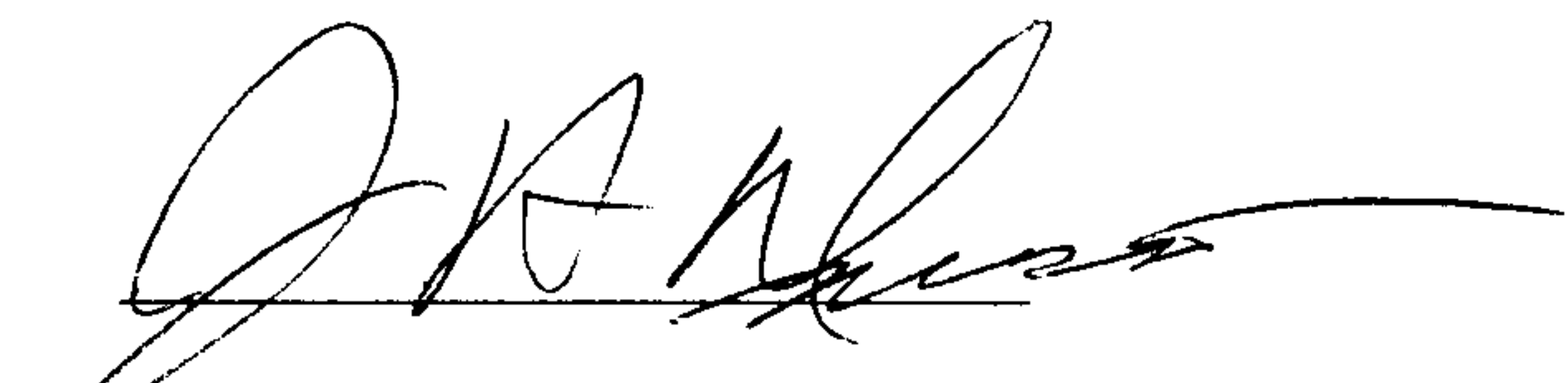
The remaining members shall have the right to continue the business after an event of dissociation terminates the continued membership of a member in the LLC.
