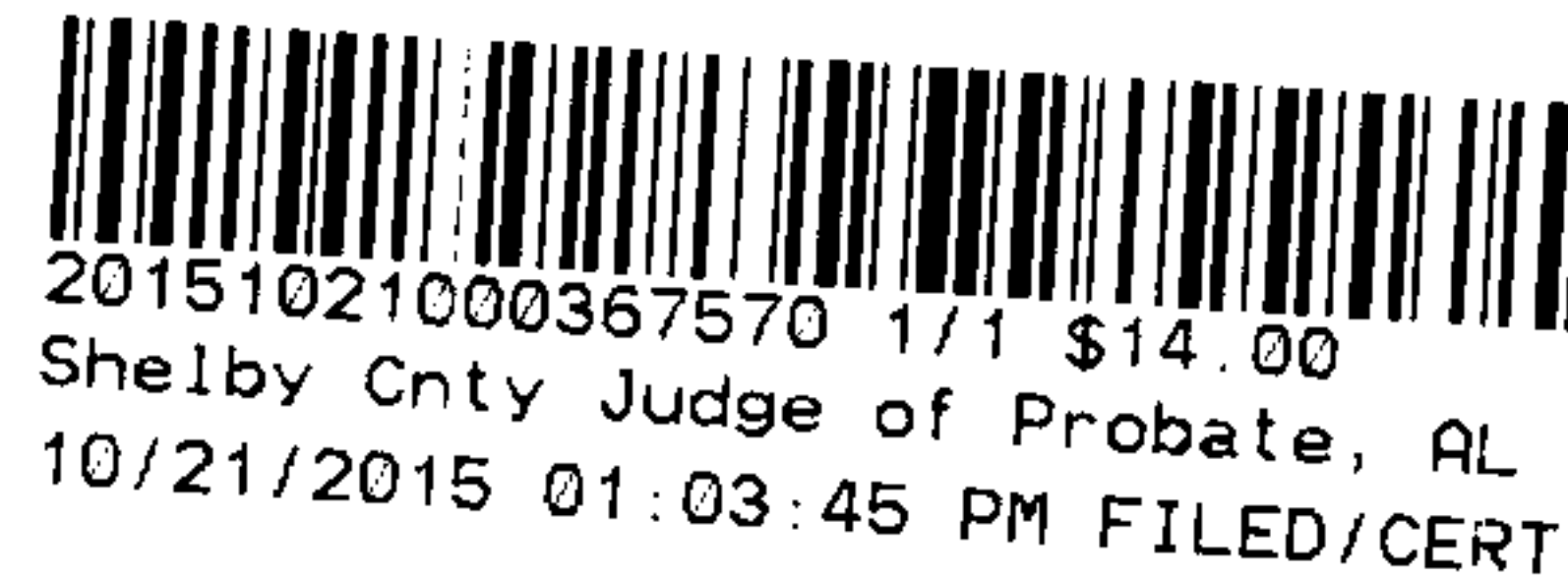

The name of the owner of the said property is Kimberly Nicole Grabeldinger and Glen Grabeldinger.


