

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

**ARTICLE 1
NAME**

The name of the limited liability company is Inscribe, LLC.

**ARTICLE 2
PERPETUALNESS**

The period of its duration is perpetual.

**ARTICLE 3
PURPOSE**

The purpose or purposes for which this limited liability company is organized is primarily to market and provide service to brokers, carriers and businesses for enrollment of employees for both group and voluntary insurance benefits and to conduct such other lawful activities and businesses for which a limited liability company may be organized under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law of 2014.

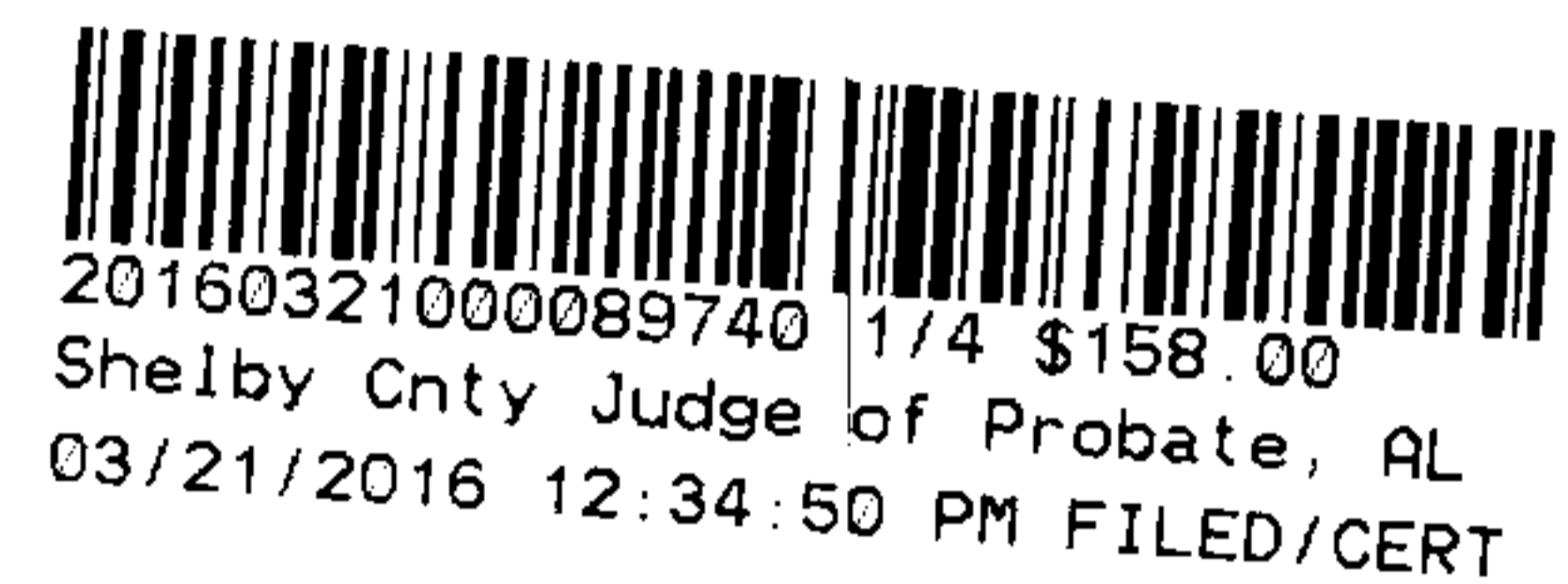

**ARTICLE 6
ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS**

The Members of the limited liability company shall have the right to admit additional and substitute Members upon unanimous written consent of the Members of the limited liability company; provided, however, so long as there shall be only one Member of the limited liability company, an assignee of such sole Member of the limited liability company shall be admitted as a substitute Member automatically in the event that the sole Member's entire membership interest (including financial and other rights) in the Company is voluntarily transferred (whether upon the dissolution of the sole Member of the Company or otherwise) to such assignee.

**ARTICLE 7
DISSOLUTION UPON CESSATION OF MEMBERS**

The cessation of membership of any Member shall not result in the dissolution of the limited liability company, except as may be expressly required by non-waivable provisions of applicable law.

**ARTICLE 8
MANAGEMENT**

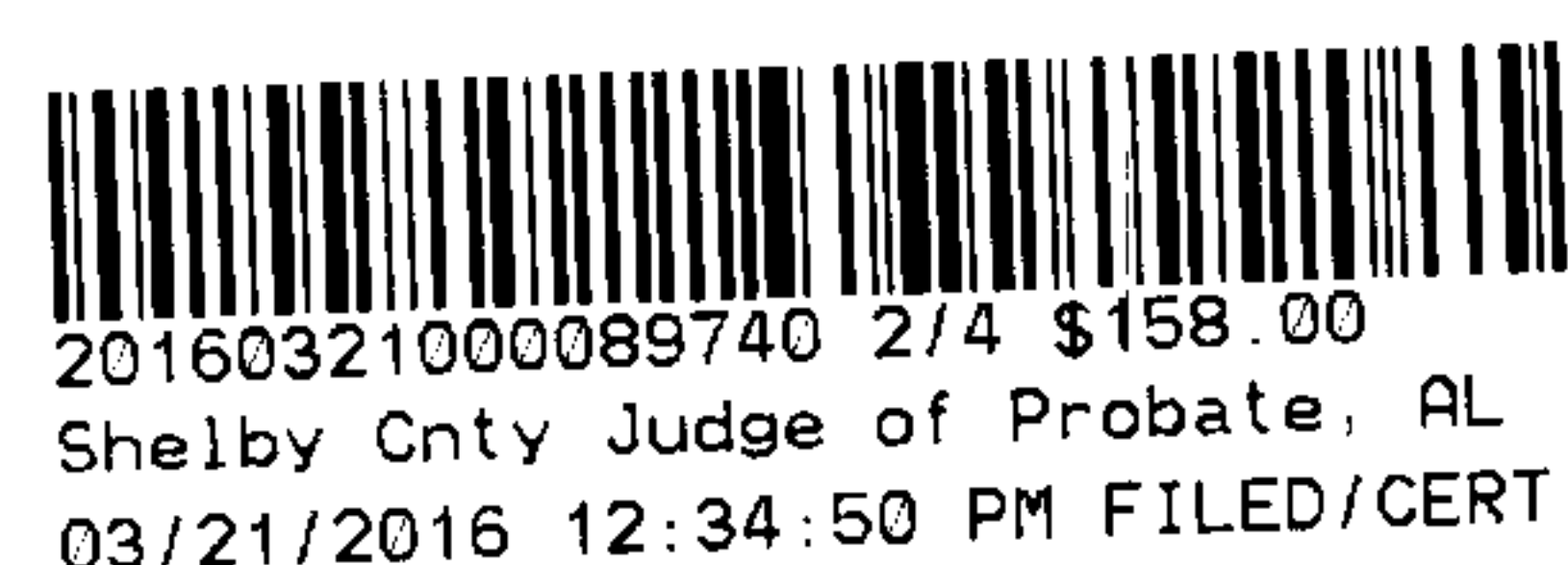


**ARTICLE 10
