

PRESENTS, that, THESE KNOW ALL MEN ΒY WHEREAS, on or about June 29, 2012, Stephen Lee Glass and Jessica Renee Glass, a married couple, executed a mortgage conveying the real estate hereinafter described in Shelby County, Alabama, to Fred Wayne Horton, as Mortgagee, which said mortgage was recorded on July 5, 2012, in Instrument #20120705000235580, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama (hereinafter referred to as "said mortgage" or words to that effect), which said mortgage and the indebtedness secured thereby is and was as of the date upon which this foreclosure proceeding was instituted, and is and was as of the date upon which this foreclosure deed was executed, the sole property of said Mortgagee; and

WHEREAS, in and by said mortgage said Mortgagee was authorized and empowered in case of default in the payment of the indebtedness thereby secured according to the terms thereof, to sell said real estate in front of the Courthouse door in the City of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, after giving twenty-one days notice of the time, place, and terms, of said sale, by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks prior to said sale in some newspaper published in Shelby County, Alabama, such sale to be at public outcry for cash, to the highest bidder, and said mortgage provided that in case of sale under the power and authority contained in the same the Mortgagee or any person conducting said sale for the Mortgagee might bid at the same and purchase said property if the highest bidder therefor; and

WHEREAS, default was made in the payment of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and such default continuing, the said Mortgagee did give due and proper notice of the foreclosure of said mortgage by publication in the Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation published in Shelby County, Alabama, in its issues of May 18, 25, and June 1, 2016, and;

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2016, at approximately 12:00 o'clock noon, being the day and approximate time on which the foreclosure sale was scheduled to be held under the terms of said notice between the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure was duly and property conducted and said Mortgagee did, in strict compliance with the power of sale contained in said mortgage, offer for sale at public outcry to the highest bidder for cash in front of the Shelby County Courthouse front door in the City of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, the real estate hereinafter described and against which said Mortgagee held a first mortgage lien; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Mike T. Atchison, was the auctioneer, agent and attorney-in-fact who conducted said foreclosure sale and was the person conducting said sale for the said Fred Wayne Horton; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and a credit in the amount of Twenty-Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighty-Two and 41/100 Dollars, toward a portion of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, the said Fred Wayne Horton, acting by and through Mike T. Atchison, as auctioneer conducting said sale and as attorney-in-fact for Stephen Lee Glass and Jessica Renee Glass, respectively, and by and through Mike T. Atchison, as auctioneer conducting said sale, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Fred Wayne Horton, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, together with all improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto, to-wit:

Commence at the SE corner of the NW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 2 West; thence run Northwardly along the East line of said ¼ -1/4 for a distance of 211.40 feet to the North right of way line of Shelby County Highway Number 22; thence turn an angle to the left of 125 degrees 23 minutes 03 seconds and run along said highway right of way a distance of 90.45 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 90 degrees for a distance of 332.88 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 90 degrees for a distance of 350.56 feet for the point of beginning; thence turn an angle to the left of 92 degrees 18 minutes 42 seconds for a distance of 164.20 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 29 degrees 39 minutes 30 seconds for a distance of 109.61 feet, more or less, to the North right of way line of said Highway Number 22; thence turn an angle to the right and run along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 680.03 feet and a central angle of 35 degrees 31 minutes 08 seconds for a distance as measured along said arc of 421.56 feet; thence leaving said right of way turn right an angle so as to run Northeasterly to the point of beginning, said line being 289.02 feet in length and a straight line continuation of the 350.56 feet line described above.




