Whereas, on the 4th day of April, 1994 a decree was rendered by the Probate Court of said county for the sale of the lands, hereinafter described, and conveyed for the state and county taxes then due from PAIR, RODDERICK RAY, the owner of said land for the costs and expenses thereof and thereunder.

MARK MCLAUGHLIN, who is the present owner and holder of said certificate of purchase all the right, title and interest of the said PAIR, RODDERICK RAY, owner of aforesaid land, and all the right, title, interest and claim of the state and county on account of said taxes, or under said decree and to the following described lands, hereinafter referred to, to-wit: parcel ID# 58//08/05/21/0/001/042/000.

being situated in said county and state, to have and to hold the same, the said right, title and interest unto itself the said J. MARK MCLAUGHLIN, and his heirs and assigns forever, but no right, title or interest of any reversioner or remainderman in said land is conveyed hereby.
