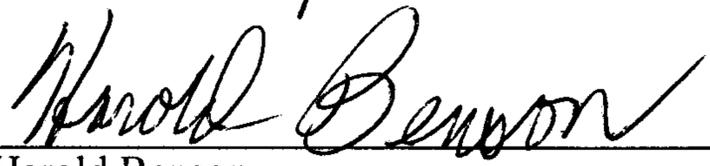

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to said GRANTEES for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them forever.

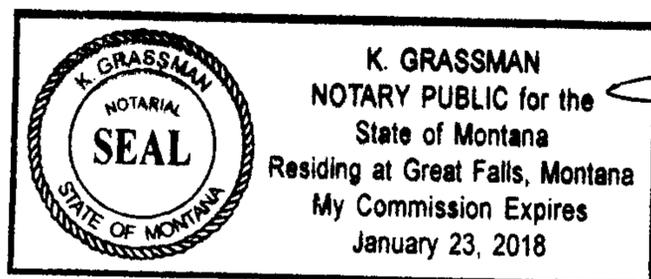

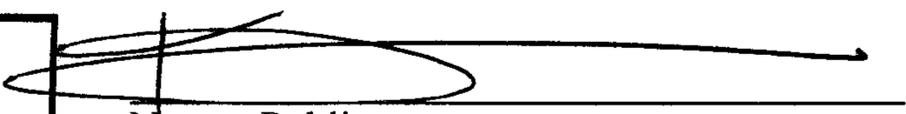

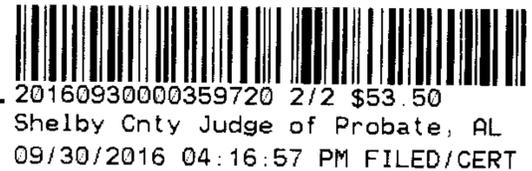
