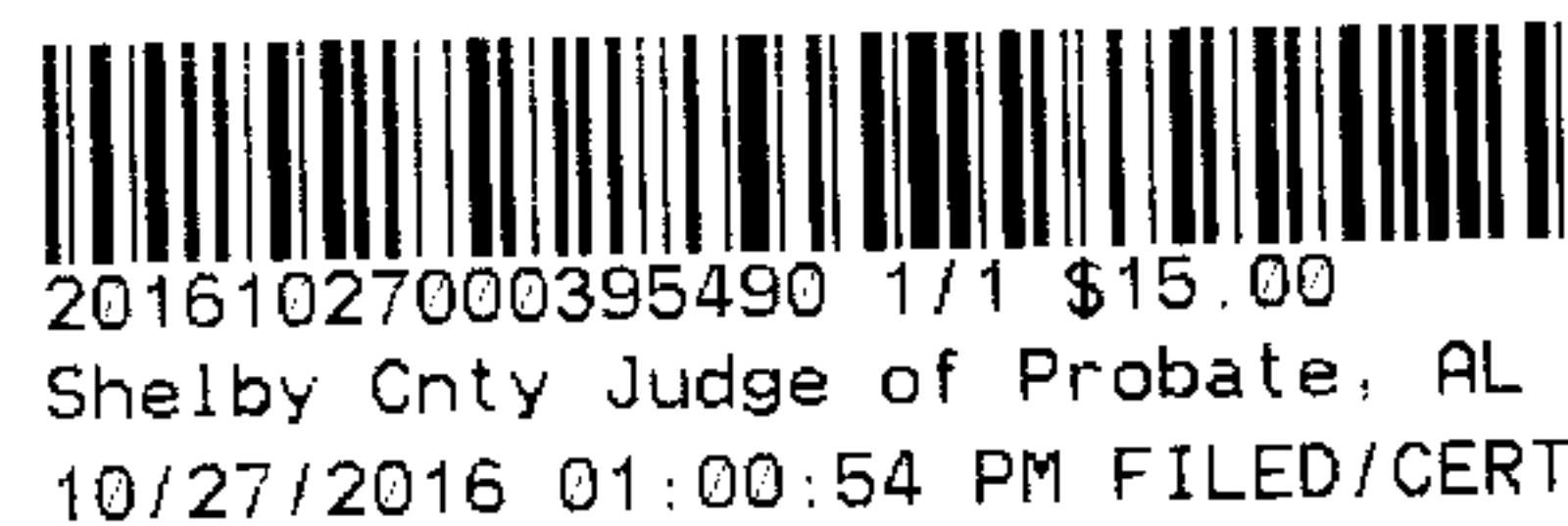

The name of the owner or proprietor of the said property is **Randall K. and Shawne M. Sisk**

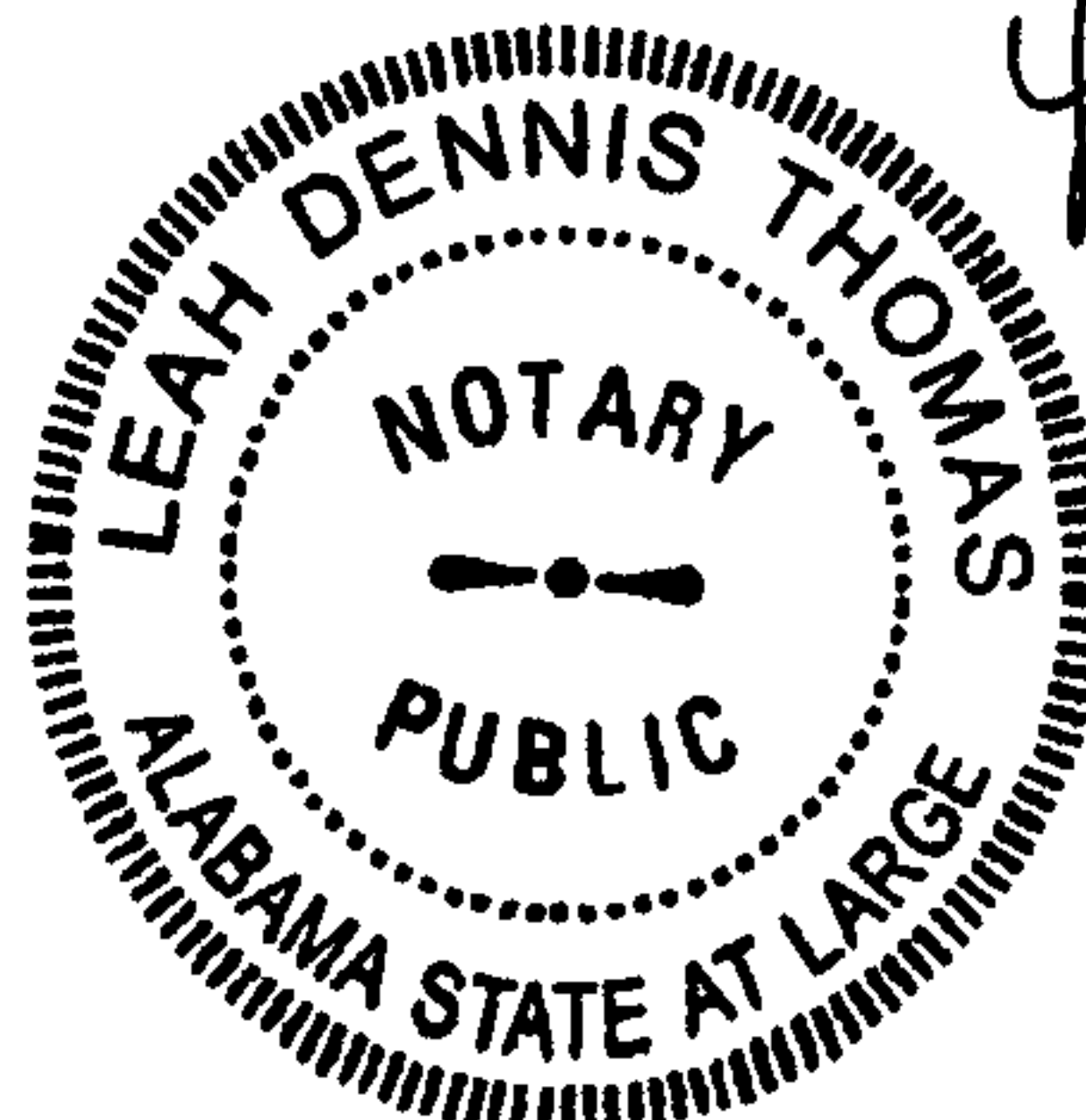
