THIS CAUSE coming before the Court on the 13" day of May, 2009, and the Court having heard testimony ore tenus, finds:

That the parties have been in domestic litigation since the year 2000.

That on April 25, 2007, Defendant caused a warrant to be issued by the City of Pelham, Alabama for the arrest of his former wife, Jan Kral, for the crime of harassing communications. The Defendant failed to appear to prosecute said case and the charge was dismissed on January 29, 2008. The Court finds that the Defendant, John Kral, did not have adequate evidence, lacked a legal basis and was without probable cause in swearing out a warrant for the Plaintiff which resulted in the Plaintiff's arrest and booking by the Pelham Police Department.

The Court finds that the Defendant misused the judicial process by causing said warrant to be issued.

Therefore, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff, Jan Kral, and against Defendant, John Kral, in the amount of \$5,000.00 plus costs of Court.
