FORECLOSURE DEED

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

WHEREAS, heretofore on, to-wit, 12/30/2004, Constance G. Palmer, An Unmarried Woman, as Mortgagors, executed a Real Estate Mortgage on the property hereinafter described to Mortgage Electronic Registration Services, Inc. NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of a credit in the amount of







