I, MINNIE PEARL HICKS, a resident citizen of Shelby County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one (21) years, of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all Wills and Codicils heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE

I hereby will and direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses, the expenses of my last illness and the costs of administration of my estate be paid by my hereinafter named Executor as soon after my death as may be practical.

ITEM TWO

I hereby will, devise, and bequeath all property which may be mine at the time of my death, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, to my children, **Henry Leo Miller, Jr., Paulette Miller Garrett, Patrice Miller Gaddis, and Albert A. Miller,** share and share alike, per stirpes, to be theirs absolutely, to have and to hold, in fee simple forever.

ITEM THREE

It is my specific intent that my husband, Johnny James Hicks, be excluded from my Last Will and Testament nor shall he receive anything from my estate.

ITEM FOUR

It is my specific intent that any vehicle I own at the time of my death be given to any of my children that so desires said vehicle, and who needs it the most, that said vehicle is to be awarded to said child by my daughter, Paulette Miller Garrett.

ITEM FIVE

It is my specific bequest that my son, Henry Leo Miller, Jr., be allowed to continue living in a house that I own in Wilton, Shelby County, Alabama. Should my children decide to sell the home then the proceeds from said home shall be disbursed evenly between my children and my niece, LaTonia Davis Rhodes, share and share alike, per stirpes.

ITEM SIX

I hereby nominate and appoint my daughter, **Paulette Miller Garrett**, to be the Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and I hereby declare that she shall **not** be required to make or file any inventory, settlement, or report to any court for his actions, nor give bond for the performance of his duties hereunder as Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. I hereby grant to and vest in my said Executrix full power and authority to continue the operation of any business activity in which I may be engaged at the time of my death, together with full power and authority to sell, at private sale, and to convey, lease, exchange, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise alienate any or all of the assets of my estate, on such terms as she deems to be proper without the order of any court, it being my purpose and intention to grant to my said Executrix all the powers over my said property

and estate that I am capable of granting to her as such Executrix and all without the order or approval of any court and without giving bond for the performance of her duties as such Executrix.

In the event that my daughter, Paulette Miller Gaddis, should not be living at the time of my death or if she for any reason fails to serve and qualify as Executrix, I hereby nominate and appoint my daughter Patrice Miller Gaddis and my sons, Henry Leo Miller, Albert A. Miller, as Joint Successor Execut(or)(rix) of this my Last Will and Testament, with all the powers, duties, and exemptions granted to and vested in my said daughter, Paulette Miller Garrett.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Minnie Pearl Hicks, the Testatrix, sign my name to this instrument, consisting of this and two preceding typewritten pages, on this the 13th day of MAY, 2014, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and Testament and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am under no constraint or undue influence, and for purposes of identifications, I have initialed each page in the presence of the persons witnessing it at my request.

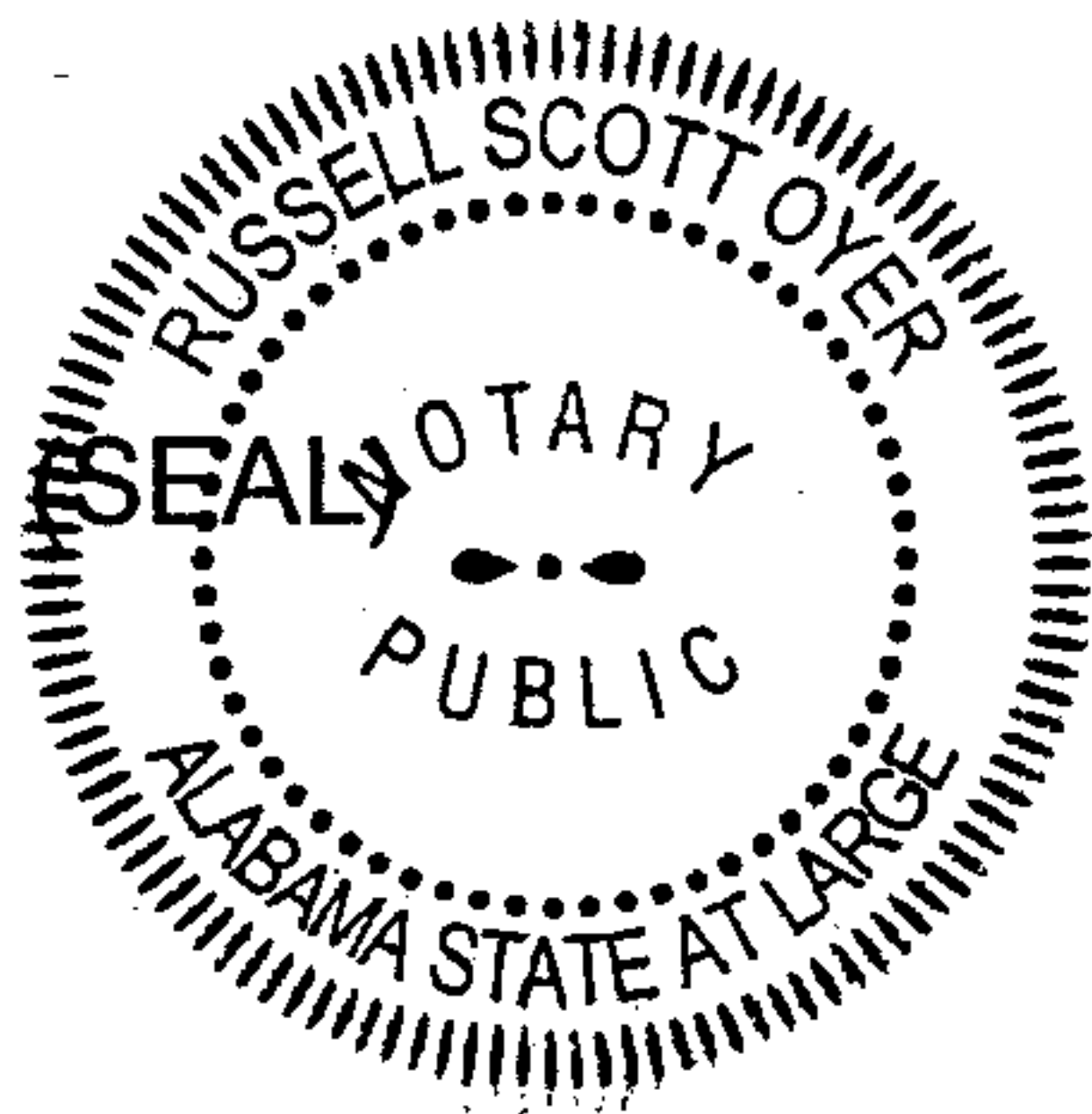
