The S½ of the SE¼ of the NE¼ and the N½ of the NE¼ of the SE¼ of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

ALSO, Easement/Right of Way Description:

A 30-foot perpetual easement and right of way for ingress and egress situated in the South½ of the NW¼ of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, the centerline of which is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the NE comer of the S½ of the NE¼ of the SE¼ of Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, and run North 35 degrees 39 minutes 06 seconds East for a distance of 278.42 feet to a point; thence turn North 23 degrees 31 minutes 06 seconds East for a distance of 209.71 feet to a point; thence run North 57 degrees 53 minutes 06 seconds East for a distance of 140.0 feet to a point; thence run North 23 degrees 49 minutes 24 seconds East for a distance of 202.91 feet to a point; thence run North 36 degrees 20 minutes 01 seconds East for a distance of 150.69 feet to a point; thence run North 89 degrees 39 minutes 05 seconds East for a distance of 48.69 feet to the point of ending of that certain 30-foot perpetual easement and right of way established by Civil Action E708-75 in Shelby County, Alabama, Civil Court of October 3, 1975.

ALSO, a 30-foot perpetual easement and right of way for ingress and egress granted by the Circuit Court in Shelby County, dated October 3, 1975, Civil Action E708-75, Description of easement is as follows:

A portion of the S½ of the NW¼ of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows: Commencing at the SE corner of said subdivision of said Section; thence North 11 chains and 77 links to a post; thence West and parallel with the South line of said subdivision of said Section to a point on the West right of way line of Shelby County Highway No. 15, which is the point of beginning of the 30-foot easement and right of way herein conveyed; thence continue along said course to a post on the East line of the W½ of the SW¼ of the NW¼ of said Section 9; thence run South along the East line of said 20 acres for a distance of 30 feet to a point; thence run East and parallel with the South line of said subdivision of said Section to a point on the West right of way of Shelby County Highway No. 15; thence run in a Northerly direction along said West right of way line to the point of beginning. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

This easement is subject to the Order of the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, dated September 20, 1994, Civil Action CV-93,689, specifying the agreement of the use of the easement.

Councilmember Sharon Anderson made a Motion to introduce Ordinance 02J, an ordinance assenting to a certain petition for annexation from Dr. Michael A Remillard and Matsy L. Remillard. Councilmember Paul Brown seconded the Motion. Councilmember Bob Lightfoot made a Motion to introduce Resolution 02JIC to suspend the agenda and give immediate consideration to Ordinance 02J. Councilmember Willie Goldsmith seconded the Motion. A vote was taken to suspend the agenda. All Ayes. The vote was unanimous. A vote was taken on Ordinance 02J. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. Lelia Mitchell was present concerning her house that partially sits on Montevallo Water and Sewer Board property. Mayor Parker turned this over to the Water and Sewer Board.

Councilmember Sharon Anderson made a Motion to introduce Ordinance 02H, which changes the rental tax from two per cent to 3 per cent to be the same as the sales and use tax. Councilmember Willie Goldsmith seconded the Motion. This will be voted on at the next regular council meeting.

Councilmember Bob Lightfoot made a Motion to introduce an ordinance correcting the name of the machine for the Dragger Alcohol Test. Councilmember Willie Goldsmith seconded the Motion. A vote will be taken on this Motion at the next regular council meeting.

Mayor Parker reported there are four openings on boards, the Board of Adjustment, Housing Authority, Park & Recreation # 2 and the Historical Commission.

Councilmember Sharon Anderson made a Motion to appoint Mr. John Crawford to the Historical Commission. This Motion will be voted on at the next regular council meeting.

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ORDINANCE NUMBER 02J

COUNCIL MEMBER ANDERSON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE.

COUNCIL MEMBER BROWN SECONDED THE ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE ASSENTING TO A CERTAIN PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property located and contained within an area contiguous to the corporate limits of Montevallo, and not within the corporate limits of any other municipality, as provided in §11-42-21 of the 1975 Alabama Code, have signed and filed a written petition with the City Clerk requesting that such property or territory be annexed to Montevallo, and

WHEREAS, said petition contains an accurate description of the property or territory proposed to be annexed together with a map of the said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of Montevallo,

E IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEVALLO, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- That the City Council of the City of Montevallo, as and for its governing body, hereby assents to the annexation of that certain land described in the attached petition for annexation of: Dr Michael A Remillard and wife Matsy L Remillard, as provided in §11-42-21 of the 1975 Alabama Code and other applicable law.
- That the annexed territory be zoned AO until it is rezoned by recommendation of the Montevallo Planning Commission.
- That the annexed territory be made a part of Council District One until such time as Council Districts are redrawn pursuant to the US Census.
- That the City Clerk is directed to file a copy of this ordinance, including a description of the property or territory annexed, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, and to advertise this ordinance as provided by law.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and advertisement as



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provided by law.


