**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:** That, for and in consideration of **Three Hundred Seven Thousand and 00/100 (\$307,000.00)**, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned **William Jeremiah Campbell and wife, Sukhkamal Bhullar Campbell**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTORS do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **David W. Hall and Jacqueline B. Hall**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of **Shelby**, State of Alabama, to-wit:

**Lot 326, according to the Final Plat of Creekside, Phase 2, Part C, as recorded in Map Book 42, Page 121, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.**

Subject To:

Ad valorem taxes for 2017 and subsequent years not yet due and payable until October 1, 2017. Existing covenants and restrictions, easements, building lines and limitations of record.

\$200,000.00 of the consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.

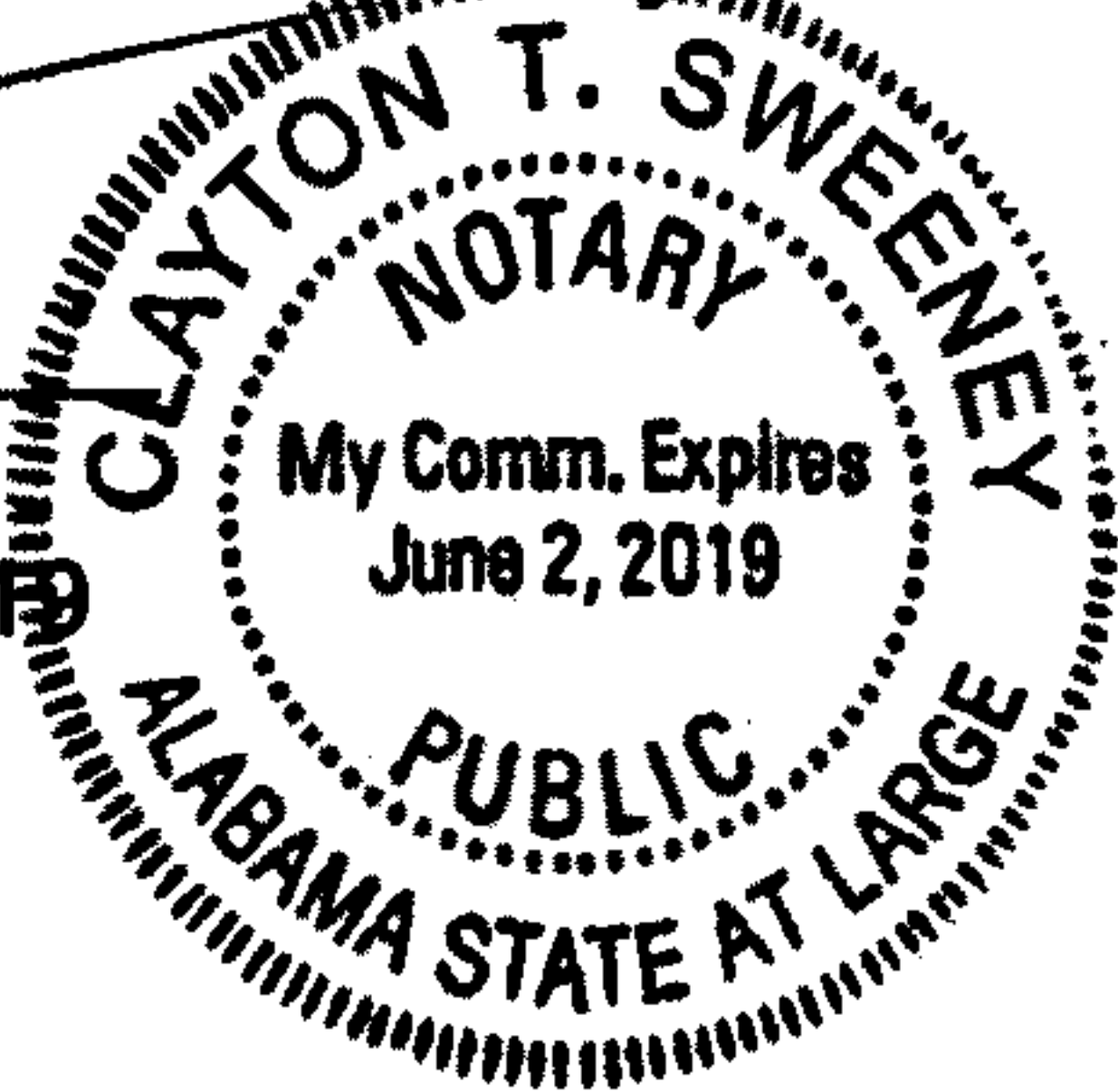

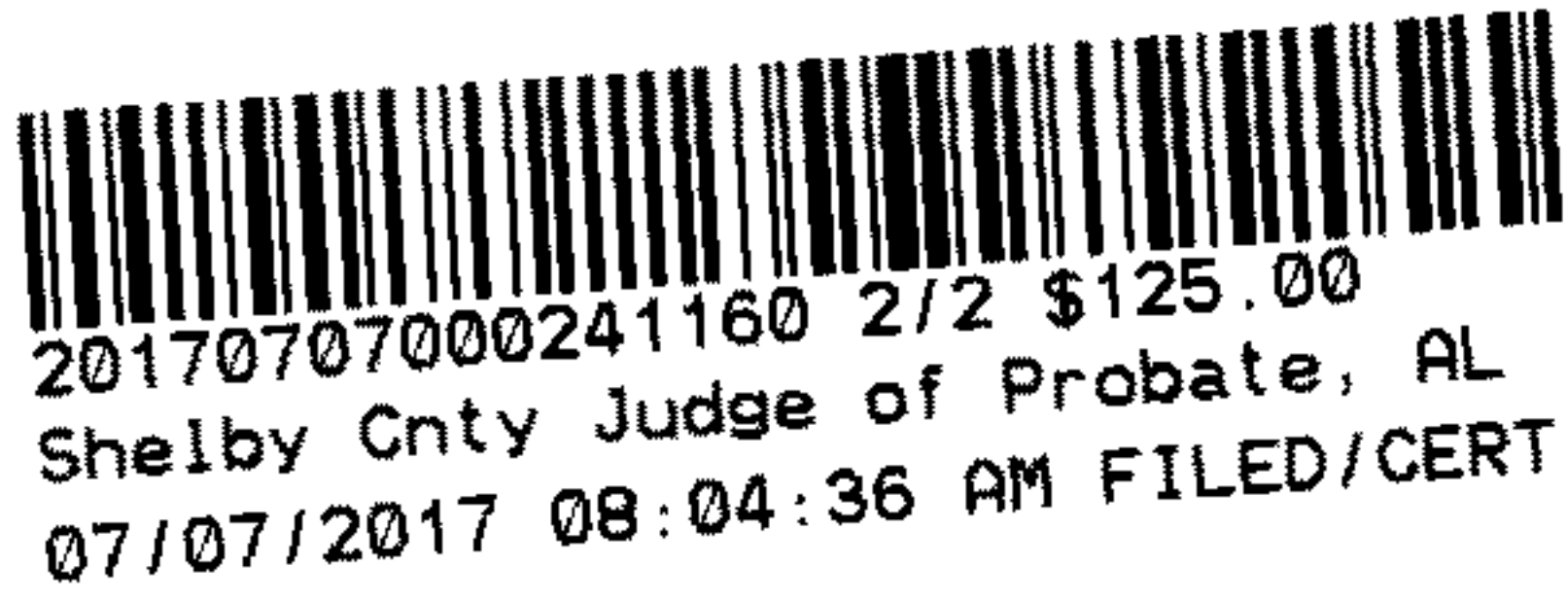
