The undersigned, for the purpose of forming an Alabama corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Business and Nonprofit Entity Code and the Alabama Business Corporation Law, as the same now exists or as may hereafter be amended (the "Law"), does hereby adopt the following Certificate of Formation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is "Bice Auto Repairs & Accessories, Inc." (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

- (a) To engage in the business of owning and operating an automotive repair business, including all acts or activities relating thereto; and
- (b) To transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Law.

ARTICLE III

The street address and mailing address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 139 1st Ave West, Alabaster, AL 35007. The name of the initial registered agent at the said registered office is Jerry L. Bice.

ARTICLE IV

The name of the organizer/incorporator is Anthony C. Willoughby, Esq., at Dominick Feld Hyde, P.C., P. O. Box 1387, Birmingham, Alabama 35201-1387.

ARTICLE V

- (a) The total number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is One Hundred (100) Common Shares, par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.
- (b) All issued and outstanding shares have the same preferences and relative rights, including, without limitation, (i) unlimited voting rights for all purposes at the rate of one vote per

share and (ii) the right to receive the net assets of the Corporation upon dissolution.

No shareholder of the Corporation shall be entitled as a matter of right to subscribe (c) for, purchase, receive or acquire as a preemptive right any shares, or other securities convertible into shares, of the Corporation which it may issue or sell, whether out of the number of shares now or hereafter authorized or out of shares now or hereafter held in its treasury, but all such additional shares or other securities may be issued or disposed of by the Board of Directors to such persons and upon such terms as in its absolute discretion it may deem advisable.

ARTICLE VI

The name and address of the individual who is to serve as the initial sole Director is (a) as follows:

A Director of the Corporation shall have no liability to the Corporation or its (b) shareholders for money damages for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a Director, except liability for (i) the amount of a financial benefit received by a Director to which he or she is not entitled; (ii) an intentional infliction of harm on the Corporation or its shareholders; (iii) a violation of Section 10A-2-8.33 of the Law; (iv) an intentional violation of criminal law; or (v) a breach of the Director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its shareholders. If the Law, or any successor statute thereto, is hereafter amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of a director of a corporation, then the liability of a Director of the Corporation, in addition to the limitations on liability provided herein, shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Law, or any successor statute thereto. No amendment to or repeal of this Article shall apply to or have any effect on the liability or alleged liability of any Director of the Corporation for or with respect to any acts or omissions of such Director occurring prior to such amendment or repeal.

It is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing reference to entity powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the Corporation otherwise granted by law.


