**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND
CERTIFYING JUDGMENT AS FINAL UNDER RULE 54(B)**

This matter came before the Court for a hearing on October 3, 2017, on Plaintiff's *Motion for Partial Summary Judgment and Entry of Order Rendering Such Judgment Final Pursuant to Rule 54(b)* [Doc. 40] (the "Motion"). In attendance at the hearing was Sam Stephens, Counsel for Plaintiff ServisFirst Bank. No appearance was made on behalf of the Defendants, and no Defendant filed anything in opposition to the Plaintiff's Motion. The Court, having considered the pleadings, the evidence before it, and the arguments of Counsel hereby:

ORDERS, ADJUDGES, and DECREES that Plaintiff's Motion is **GRANTED**. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of ServisFirst Bank against Defendant Lenn Waters Morris on Count I in the amount of \$ 2,404,604.81; and on Counts II, III, and IV in the amount of \$6,737.60, together with the costs of this action. Interest shall accrue on this Judgment at the contract rate of 7.5%. This also Court **FINDS** that there is no just reason to delay entry of a final judgment on Counts I through IV, and hereby certifies this Judgment as final under Rule 54(b).
