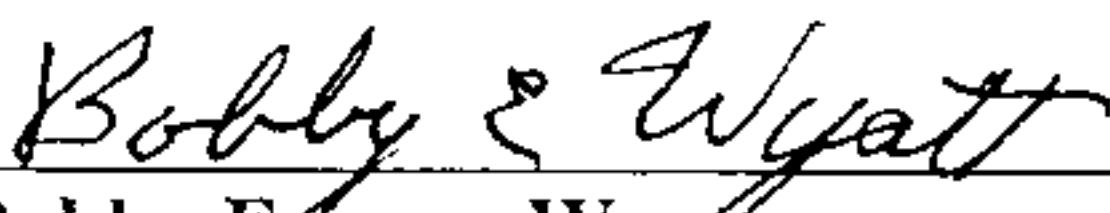
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, **Bobby Eugene Wyatt**, of Bibb County, Alabama, the undersigned, DO HEREBY MAKE, CONSTITUTE AND APPOINT **Elizabeth Jean Black** of Bibb County, Alabama, my true and lawful Attorney in Fact, for me and in my name, place and stead, and on behalf and for my use and benefit, to do, perform and execute all and every act that I may legally do through an attorney in fact, and every proper power necessary to carry out the purposes for which this power is granted, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and affirming that which the said **Elizabeth Jean Black** or her substitute shall lawfully do or cause to be done by herself or her substitute lawfully designated by virtue of the power hereby conferred upon her.

As my Attorney In Fact, **Elizabeth Jean Black** powers shall include, but are not limited to: the right to demand, sue for, recover, collect, and receive all sums of money, debts, accounts, legacies, bequests, interest, dividends, annuities, and demands whatsoever as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, payable, or belonging to me and have, use, and take all lawful means for the recovery thereof, and to compromise and give discharges for the same; for me and in my name, to make, deliver, bargain, sell, contract, agree for, purchase, receive, and take any and all legal actions with respect to my financial affairs and/or personal property and/or real property including but not limited to the endorsement of checks, drafts, notes, bills of sale, titles and any other commercial paper in my name and to withdraw money from any of my checking and/or savings accounts and to sign orders or receipts thereof in my name and to convey and/or transfer title to any of my motor vehicles.

I grant my agent and any successor agent general authority to act for me with respect to the following subjects as defined in the Alabama Uniform Power of Attorney Act, Chapter 1A, Title 26, Code of Alabama 1975.

The rights, powers and authority of my said Attorney in Fact herein granted shall commence upon the execution of this instrument and shall be in full force and effect upon the execution of this instrument; the authority herein conferred shall not be affected by disability, incompetency, or incapacity of the said principal, **Bobby Eugene Wyatt**; and such rights, powers and authority shall remain in full force and effect until the death of the principal, **Bobby Eugene Wyatt**, or under his disability, competency, or incapacity is otherwise terminated by order of a court of competent jurisdiction. Any action taken in good faith pursuant to the foregoing authority without actual knowledge of my death shall be binding upon me, my heirs, assigns, and personal representatives.

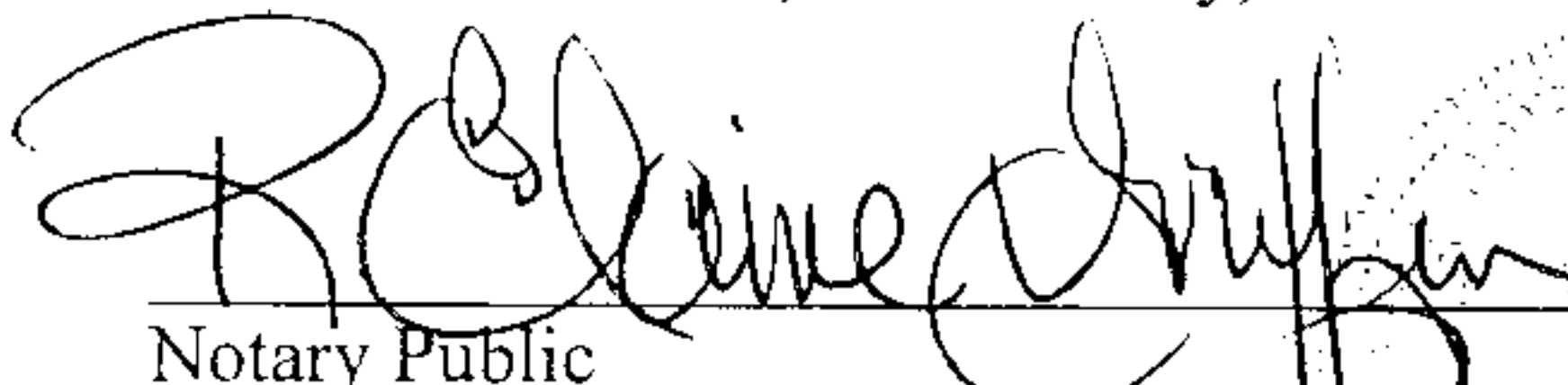
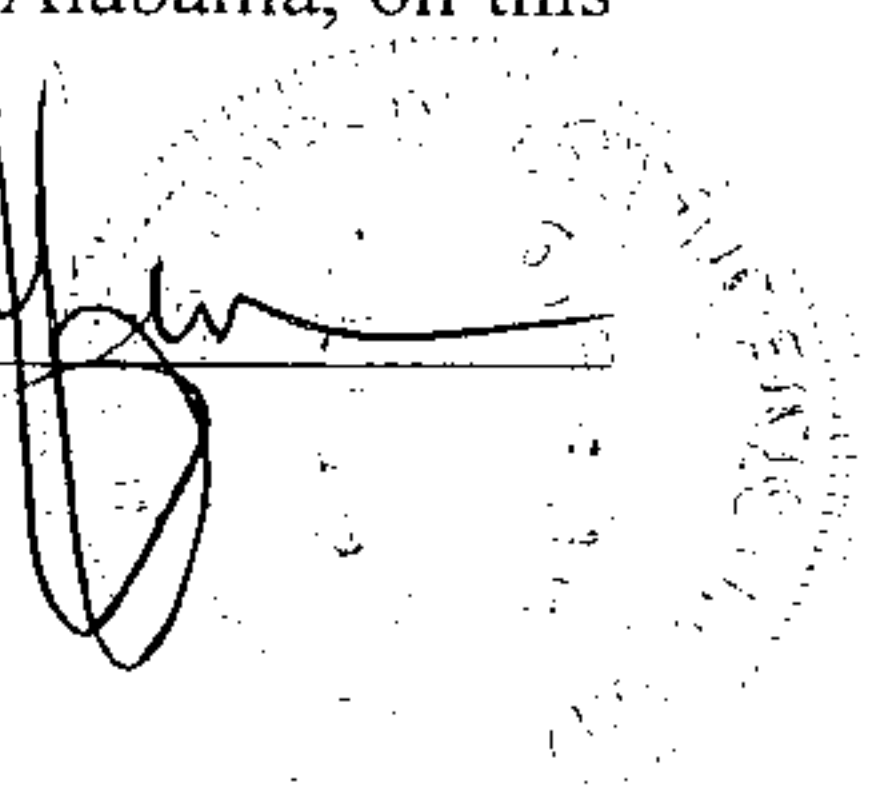
