James Keyes Watts departed this life on August 31, 2007.



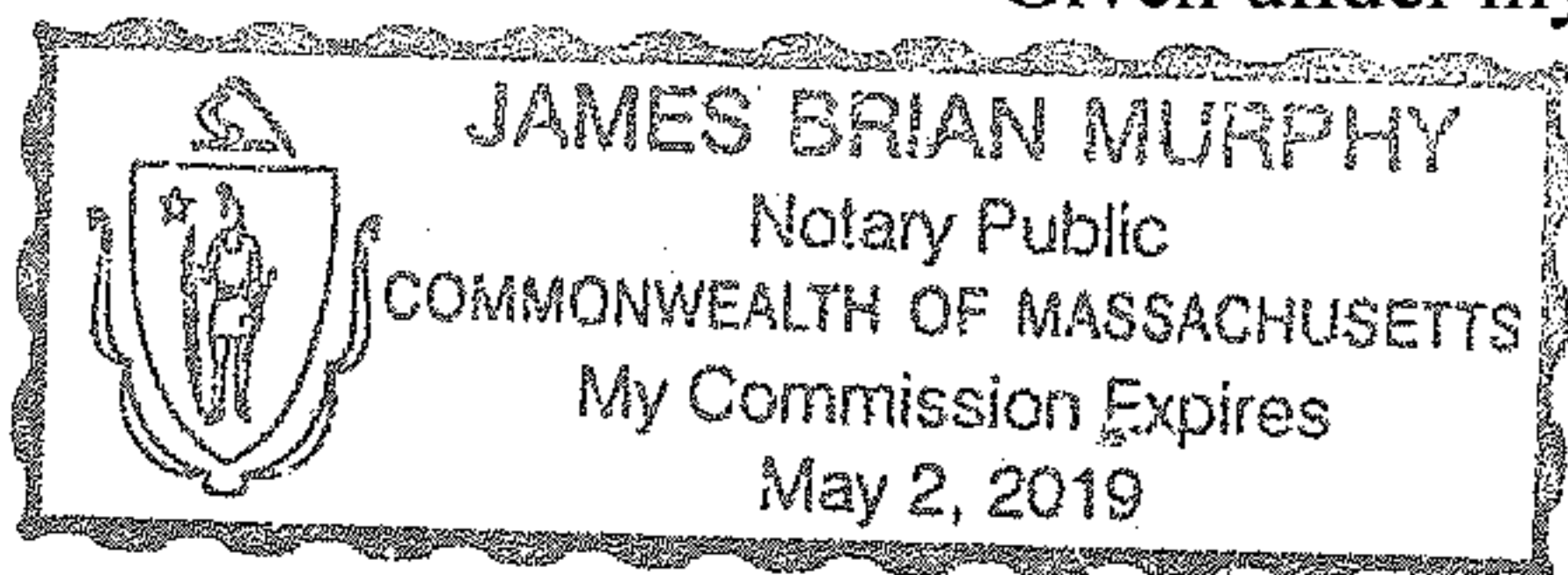
