There are 5 pocket watches. Four of them are tagged and the 5th is for Tyler Young.

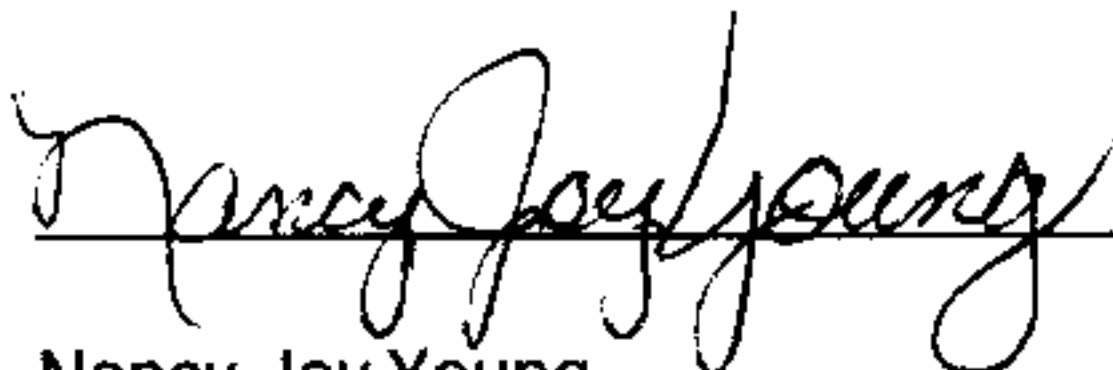
Brody Young is to have the wallet gun.

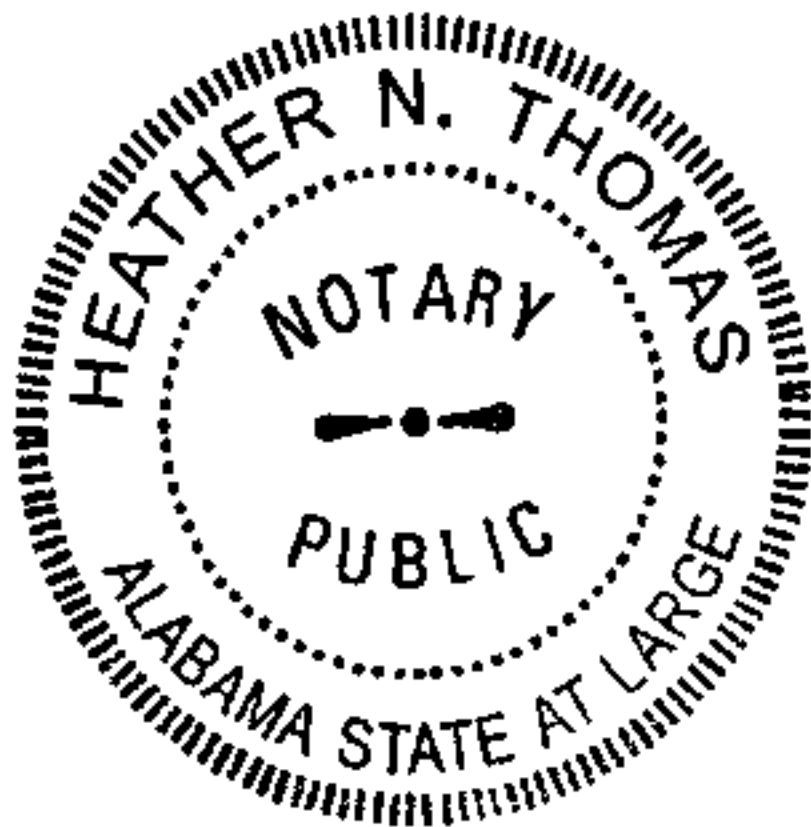
Any vehicle I own at the time of my death should be given to Brentleigh Young with insurance to be at her own expense.
