
Powers

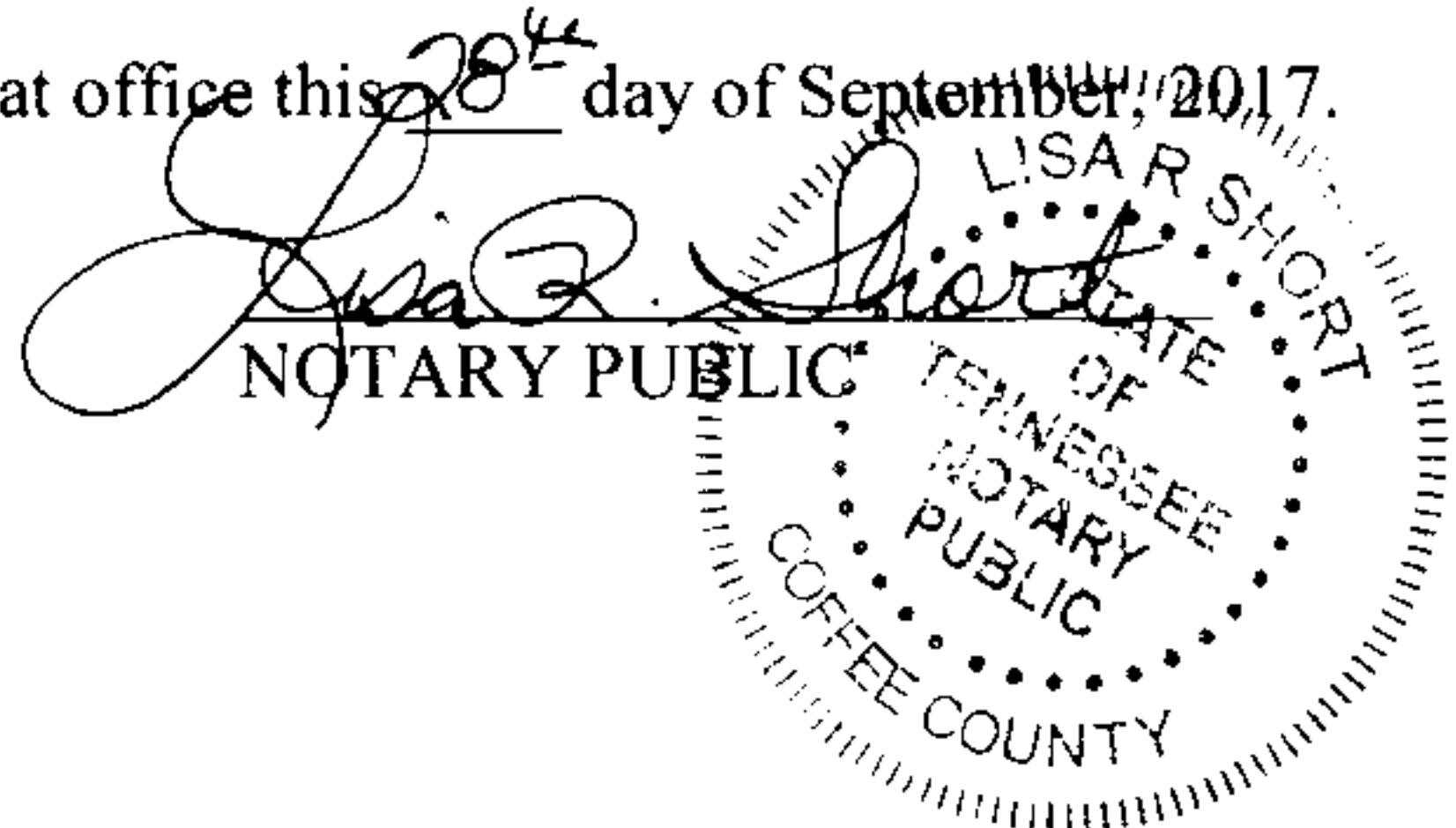
