

ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OF 316 MINISTIRES, INC.

The undersigned, pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama §10A-3-7.05, as amended from time to time (the "Act"), submits the following Articles of Dissolution:

- 1. Name. The name of the Alabama Nonprofit Corporation is "316 Ministries, Inc." (the "Company"). The Alabama Entity ID Number is 278-450.
- 2. Date of Initial Filing. The original Articles of Incorporation were filed on March 22, 2013 in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama.
- 3. Reason for Filing Articles of Dissolution. The Board of Directors has elected to dissolve the company as permitted by the Bylaws of the Company and Code of Alabama §10A-3-7.05requiring the Company to dissolve and wind up its affairs.
- 4. Written Consent. Pursuant to the Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation of the Company, the board of directors has executed a written consent to dissolve the Company as of November 29, 2017. These Articles of Dissolution are executed by Counsel for the Company as authorized by the written consent of the Board of Directors authorizing the dissolution of the Company.
- 5. **Debts, Obligations, and Liabilities.** All debts, obligations, and liabilities of the Company have been paid and discharged. The Company shall provide notice of the dissolution to any creditors discovered after the filing of these articles of dissolution.
- **6. Distribution.** Any assets or property lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed pursuant to Section 2.3(c) of the Bylaws of the Company and as permitted by the Internal Revenue Code for a nonprofit entity.
- 7. Judgments. There are no suits pending or judgments entered against the Company.

These articles of dissolution are effective immediately as of December 15, 2017.
