## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION



## THREE HEARTS ONE MISSION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act and each of who is over the age of twenty-one (21) years, sign and file this Articles of Incorporation as follows:

- 1. The name of the Corporation shall be THREE HEARTS ONE MISSION
- 2. The objects and purposes for which the corporation are formed are:
  - (a) To promote such lawful purposes allowed under Section 10-3A-4 of the Alabama Code (1978). Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, benevolent, and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 3. The corporation shall have the power, either directly or indirectly either alone or in conjuntion or cooperation with others, to do any and all lawful acts and things and to engage in any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, suitable, desirable, or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering or attainment of any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized, and to aid or assist other organizations whose activities are such as to further, accomplish, foster, or attain any of such purposes. Not withstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations of this kind under the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations thereunder as the same now exist or as they may be hereafter amended from time to time.
- 4. The general welfare of the association, not individual profit, is the object for which this corporation is organized and the members are not stockholders in the



legal sense of the term, and no dividend or profit shall be divided among the members. The corporation shall not operate any listing service for its members, or take steps, which will serve to facilitate the transaction of specific business by its members or promote the private interest of any member, or engage in any activities, which would constitute a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit.

- 5. The Corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private member or individual. In the event of liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary, no member shall be entitled to ant distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and assets shall be applied and distributed pursuant to the appropriate provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, and the regulations thereunder as the same now exists or as may be hereafter amended from time to time.
- The location of the Corporation shall be in the City of Calera, County of Shelby, State of Alabama.
- 7. The names and addresses of the Incorporators are as follows:

- 8. The numbers of directors shall be established by the by-laws, but in no event shall such number be less than two (2) nor more than twenty-five (25).
- 9. The names and addresses of the directors who shall hold office until the first annual meeting of members and until their successors have been elected and qualified are as follows:



- 10. The name and address of the initial registered agent of the Corporation is Rachel Davidson, 15147 Hwy. 25, Calera, AL 35040 and the address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is Three Hearts One Mission, 15147 Highway 25, Calera, Alabama 35040.
- 11. The period for the duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.




- 12. The corporation shall have but one (1) class of members and each member shall have one vote on each matter submitted at a meeting of members.
- 13. The corporate powers shall be exercised by the Board of Directors except as otherwise provided by statute or by these Articles of Incorporation. The Board if Directors shall be elected by its members.

In the furtherance and not in limitation of powers conferred by State, the Board is hereby expressly authorized:

- (a) To adopt, alter, amend and repeal the by-laws of the Corporation.
- (b) To appoint such subordinate officers and agents in addition to the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, as the purposes of the Corporation may require and to designate the name of such office.
- (c) To accept members upon proper application, the incorporators and directors being members without the necessity of formal application.

The Corporation may, in its by-laws confer upon its Board if Directors, in addition to the foregoing and in addition to the powers and authority expressly conferred upon Directors by statute, such additional powers as are appropriate.

- 14. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 15. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by any organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 16. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate in public office.
- 17. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations described in sections 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2)



of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.




