Publication of the pendency of this action was made in the Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation in Shelby County, Alabama on April 18, April 25, May 2, and May 9, 2018, calling upon the defendant, Natalay Woods, LLC, and its heirs and devisees if dissolved or deceased, to plead, answer or otherwise defend on or before the 12th day of June, 2018. More than sixty days has elapsed from the date of the first publication of said notice and the filing of a certified copy thereof in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

name of the Plaintiff in possession of the property in the reverse index.

services rendered in this action.

4. Costs of this action are taxed to the Plaintiff.
