NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Tribal Coatings Incorporated. (hereinafter the "Corporation")

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The duration of the corporation is and shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES


Section One: The primary purpose of this corporation is to engage in the practice of general commercial and or industrial painting, coatings, linings, sandblasting and construction.

Section Two: To include the performance of such other acts and things consistent with the aforesaid purposes for which the corporation is organized, as are necessary for or incidental to the accomplishment of these purposes.

Section Three: To include the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, Alabama Code \$ 10-28-2.02, et seg, (1994 and as amended)

Subsection A: To sue and be sued, complain and defend, in its corporate name;

Subsection B: To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at will, and to use it, or a facsimile thereof, by impressing or affixing it or in any manner reproducing it;



<u>Subsection C:</u> To make and amend bylaws, not inconsistent with its articles of incorporation or with the laws of this state, for managing the business and regulating the affairs of the corporation;

<u>Subsection D:</u> To purchase, take, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property and assets;

<u>Subsection E:</u> To sell, convey, mortgage, encumber, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets;

<u>Subsection F:</u> To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire; own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of; and deal in and with shares or other interests in, or obligations of, any other entity;

<u>Subsection G:</u> To make contracts, including guarantee and suretyship contracts and indemnity agreements, incur liabilities, borrow money, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations (which may be convertible into or include the option to purchase other securities of the corporation), secure any of its obligations (or the obligations of others for whom it can make guarantees, whether or not a guarantee is made) by mortgage or pledge of or creation of security interests in all or any of its property, franchises, or income, and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- Make contracts of guaranty and suretyship and indemnity agreements that are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or attainment of the business or the contracting corporation, and
- 2. Make contracts of guarantee and suretyship and indemnity agreements that are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the business of:
 - a. An entity that is wholly owned, directly or indirectly, by the contracting corporation, or
 - b. A person that owns, directly or indirectly, all of the outstanding stock of the contracting corporation, or
 - c. An entity that is wholly owned, directly or indirectly, by a person that owns, directly or indirectly, all of the outstanding stock of this corporation.;

<u>Subsection H:</u> To lend money for any lawful purpose, invest and reinvest its funds, and receive and hold real and personal property as security for repayment;

<u>Subsection I:</u> To be promoter, incorporator, partner, member, trustee, associate, or manager of any domestic or foreign corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other entity:

<u>Subsection J:</u> To conduct its business, locate offices, and exercise the powers granted by this chapter in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any foreign country;

Subsection L: To pay pensions and establish pension plans, pension trusts, profit-sharing plans, share bonus plans, share option plans, or other welfare, benefit or incentive plans for any or all of its current, future, or former directors, officers, employees, and agents;

Subsection M: To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.

Subsection N: To transact any lawful business which the manager or members find will be in aid of the government policy.

Subsection O: To make payments, donations, or do any other act, not inconsistent with the law, that furthers the business and affairs of the corporation.

Section Four: These purposes herein expressed shall be construed as powers as well as objects and purposes and the matters expressed in each clause thereof shall, except as otherwise expressly provided, be in no way limited by references to or inference from the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the meaning of general terms of the powers of the corporation now or hereafter conferred by law, nor shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another not expressed, although it be of like nature.




