AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Sue Garrett, who, being known to me and being by me first duly sworn, deposed and said as follows:

1. My name is Sue Garrett. I am an adult resident of Harpersville, Shelby County, Alabama, and I was one of the plaintiffs in a case in the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, Case No. CV2006-000912. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained in this Affidavit.

2. The property described in Count II of the complaint in Case No. CV2006-000912 is:

The N½ of the NE¼ of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

I acquired ownership of this property, less certain parcels which had been conveyed to others, as set out below. This information is based on my personal knowledge of my extended family and on the copies of recorded documents attached hereto as Exhibits:

A. The property was originally owned by Archie E. Wyatt. As part of the administration of his estate, in 1941, the Shelby County Probate Court decreed that Ella Wyatt, Mamie Wyatt (same as Mamie Wyatt Stone), and Lynda Mae Wyatt (same as Lynda Mae Wyatt Strickland) each owned an interest in the property. See **Exhibit A**.

B. In 1956, Ella Wyatt deeded her interest in 4.62 acres of this property to Vester (Dick) Wyatt and Janie Wyatt by deed recorded in Deed Book 183, page 249, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Ella Wyatt died testate in 1960, leaving her interest in a 4 acre square in the NE corner of the property to Rosa Lee Wyatt and Roxie Wyatt as joint tenants with survivorship. She left her interest in the remaining 71 acres, more or less, as follows: life estate to Rosa Lee Wyatt Caddell, who died in 2001, and Roxie Wyatt, who died in 1964, with remainder equally to Mamie Wyatt Stone, Vester Wyatt, and Lynda Mae Wyatt Strickland. See **Exhibit B**.

C. Mamie Wyatt Stone died testate in 2001, leaving her interest in this property to me. See **Exhibit C**.

D. Vester "Dick" Wyatt died intestate in 1990, leaving as his heirs at law his widow, Jane Wyatt, and 3 children, Jenny Rowe, Sherry Snyder, and Jane Cobb. Jane Wyatt died


intestate in 1997, leaving as her only heirs at law the same three children. All three children deeded their interests in the property to me by deed recorded as Instrument # 20100505000140920 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

E. Lynda Mae Wyatt Strickland was my mother. She died intestate in 1996, leaving me as her sole heir at law.

3. The judgments in Case No. CV2006-000912 resulted in any claims to this property which may have been made by the other descendants of Ella Wyatt being transferred to me.



In the Matter of the Estate of Archie E. Wyatt, deceased.

This being the day set by the court, by decree of the 23rd day of October, 1941, to hear and pass upon the report of the Commissioners setting aside a homestead to Ella Wyatt, the widow of Archie E. Wyatt, deceased, and to Mamie Wyatt and Lynda Mae Wyatt, who were minor children of said Archie E. Wyatt at the time of his death; and it appearing to the court that all of the heirs at law and next of kin of said Archie E. Wyatt, deceased, have been notified that said Ella Wyatt, Mamie Wyatt and Lynda Mae Wyatt on the 3rd day of September, 1941, filed their petition in writing and under oath, seeking to have set aside to them a homestead or homestead exemptions out of the real estate owned by said Archie E. Wyatt at the time of his death, and that a decree was entered in said cause on said date appointing John Baker and Henry Morris as Commissioners to set apart and allot to petitioners a homestead or homestead exemptions as prayed for in the petition, and that said Commissioners on the 10th day of September, 1941, filed their written report in this court setting aside to said petitioners the following described land as a homestead, as prayed for, viz:

The north half of the north east quarter of Section 32,
Township 19, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama,

and that in said report said commissioners valued said homestead at thirteen hundred dollars, after deducting the sum of seven hundred dollars, which represents the amount due by mortgage on said land, that is to say, they reported the net value of said property to be thirteen hundred dollars, and reported that it was all the land that said Archie E. Wyatt owned at the time of his death, and that it was occupied by him as a homestead at the time of his death, and that it did not exceed one hundred and sixty acres in area and that title was vested absolutely in them, that is, in petitioners, and that this day has been set by the court for the hearing of said report and for action thereon; and it further appearing to the Court that Ernest Wyatt and Roy Wyatt were notified of the aforementioned proceedings by citation served on them by Holt McDowell, Sheriff of Jefferson County, Alabama, on the 14th day of September, 1941, and that Clara Wyatt Harris, Roxie Wyatt, Rosalie Wyatt and Vester Wyatt, were notified of the



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aforementioned proceedings by citation served on them by W. B. White,
as Sheriff of Shelby County, Alabama, on the 30th day of October, 1941.


Thereupon said report is heard before the Court and proof
being made as to the facts set forth in the petition and in the report of the
Commissioners, the court is of the opinion that petitioners are entitled
to the relief prayed for:

It is, thereupon, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court
that the report of the Commissioners filed in this cause on the 10th
day of September, 1941, be and the same is hereby ratified and
confirmed and that the land so set aside by said Commissioners to the
petitioners in this cause, viz:

The north half of the north east quarter of Section 32,
Township 19 Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama,
was the homestead of said Archie E. Wyatt at the time of his death, that
the same was of no greater value than two thousand dollars, and of less
area than one hundred and sixty acres, and it has continued to be of less
value than two thousand dollars continuously to this time, and that it
was all the property owned by said Archie E. Wyatt at the time of his
death, and that the same be and hereby is set aside as a homestead to
said Ella Wyatt, as the surviving widow of Archie E. Wyatt, and to
Mamie Wyatt and Lynda Mae Wyatt, minor children of said Archie E. Wyatt
at the time of his death, and that they be and are vested with fee simple
title to said property.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court
that said report of said Commissioners as aforesaid be and the same is
hereby ratified and confirmed, and the property therein described be and the
same is set aside and said property is set aside to petitioners in fee simple
title as a homestead, and that the cost of this proceeding be taxed against
petitioners for which let execution issue.

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I, Ella Wyatt, of Harpersville, Shelby County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory and being mindful of the certainty of death and of the uncertainty of life, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills, if any, by me made, viz:

ITEM ONE: It is my will that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as possible.

ITEM TWO: I will, devise and bequeath to my daughters, Rosa Lee Wyatt and Roxie Wyatt, a 4 acre square of land in the NE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 19, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama, as joint tenants with the right of survivorship, reserving however, a life estate unto myself in said property. In the event one of said devisees survive the other, the entire land will go the survivor in fee simple.

ITEM THREE: I will, devise and bequeath to my two daughters Rosa Lee Wyatt and Roxie Wyatt, all other real estate I may own at the time of my death; reserving unto myself a life estate in said property. Said land bequeathed in this item shall be for the life only of my said two daughters and in the event either of them should die the other will take the entire land for her life time, that is the life time of the one surviving. At the termination of the life estate herein created in my two daughters, I will, devise and bequeath said land, not including the 4 acres bequeathed in Item 2, to my three children, Mamie Wyatt Logan, Vester Wyatt and Lynda Mae Wyatt Strickland, share and share alike.

I strickly provide herein that I shall have a life estate in all of said land and Will takes effect only at my death.

ITEM FOUR: I will, devise and bequeath to my two daughters Rosa Lee Wyatt and Roxie Wyatt, all personal property of which I may die seized possessed.

ITEM FIVE: I hereby constitute and appoint my daughter, Roxie Wyatt, as Executrix of this will, without bond.

It is therefore ORDERED by this Court that the said instrument which purports to be the Will of the said decedent was duly and legally executed by **Mamie Stone** and that the said instrument is the legal Will of the said decedent; that the said Will is hereby admitted to probate and record in this Court and that pursuant to **Ala. Code, §43-2-21 (1975)**, Letters Testamentary be granted to **Sue Garrett** as Personal Representative under said Will.

It is further ORDERED by this Court that the said Personal Representative shall have all the powers and duties provided in the Will and all the general powers, without limitation, authorized for transactions enumerated in **Ala. Code §43-2-843 (1975, as amended)**.

It is further ORDERED that the said Personal Representative proceed without delay to collect and take possession or control of the personal property and evidences of debt of the said decedent, except the personal property exempted under **Ala. Code, §43-8-111 (1975, as amended)**, in favor of the surviving spouse. The Will expressly relieves the Personal Representative of the requirement to file an inventory. The said self-proved Will of the decedent shall be recorded in the probate records of Shelby County, Alabama as provided by law.
