6. In the event of the death or incapacity of any of the Trustees, the names of the successor Trustees for the Trust is:



Regarding matters of real estate, all powers of the Trustee are fully set forth in detail in said Trust. ARTICLE IX.

8. The Trust is Revocable and there have been no amendments limiting the powers of the Trustee over trust property. The Trust becomes Irrevocable upon the death of the Settlor.
9. No Trustee shall be liable for acts or omissions in administering the trust estate or any trust created by the Agreement, except for that Trustee's own actual fraud, gross negligence or willful misconduct.


