WARRANTY DEED
Joint Tenancy With Right of Survivorship

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that in consideration of **Three Hundred Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$305,000.00)** and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency whereof is hereby acknowledged, **Matthew Scott Peebles**, a married man (herein referred to as GRANTOR) does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **Christopher J. Brymer and Allison P. Brymer, husband and wife** (herein referred to as GRANTEE, whether one or more) as joint tenants with right of survivorship, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 29, according to the Amended Map of Rushing Parc, Sector Two, as recorded in Map Book 20, Page 33, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

SUBJECT TO: (1) Ad valorem taxes for current and subsequent years, (2) easements, restrictions reservations, rights-of-way, limitations, covenants and conditions of record, if any, (3) mineral and mining rights not owned by the Grantor, if any.

Note: \$299,475.00 of the purchase price is being paid by the proceeds of a first mortgage loan executed and recorded simultaneously herewith.

This property is not the homestead of the grantor or his spouse as defined by the Code of Alabama.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, unto the said GRANTEES as joint tenants with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the Grantees herein) in the event that one Grantee survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall be owned by the surviving Grantee, and if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the Grantees shall take as tenants in common.

And said GRANTOR does for itself, its successors and assigns, covenant with said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all encumbrances, that it has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid, and that it will, and its successors and assigns shall, warrant and defend the same to the said GRANTEES, their heirs, executors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

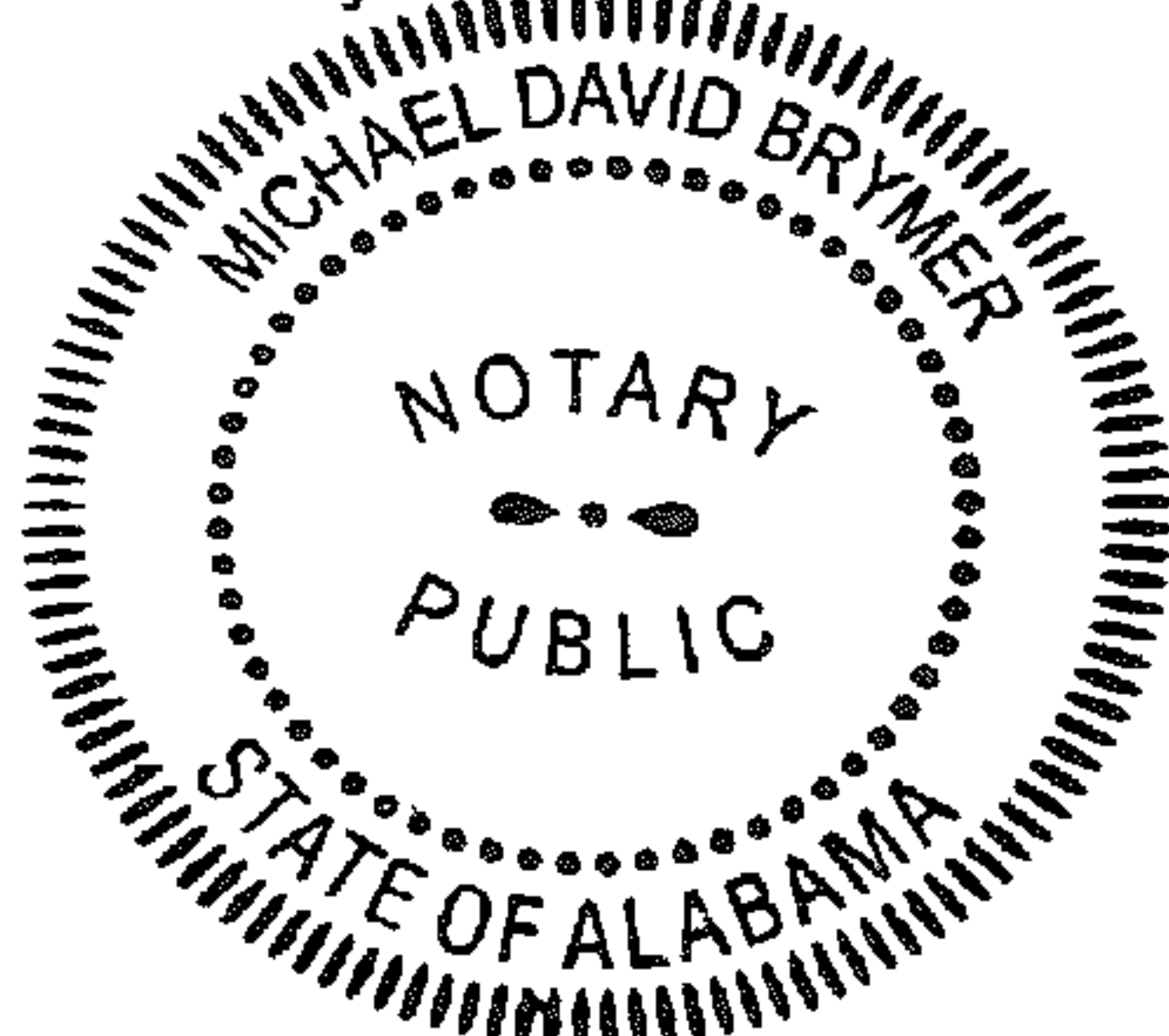
